Social Media Component

Made in CA Definition – How a Manufacturer Qualifies

- Company is registered with either a primary or secondary manufacturing NAICS code (CMTC will verify)
- Supply chain manufacturers located within California will be considered
- The product's final assembly, manufacturing or processing must take place in California and the manufacturing facility must be located in California
