### DESCRIPTION

Featuring stunning architecture and a sophisticated interior, the timeless Steinhart Hotel is reminiscent of a glamorous residence of the 1930s. Honored as a member of Historic Hotels of America, the Steinhart Hotel was originally built in 1910 as an apartment house by Ignatz Steinhart, the San Francisco banker who founded the Steinhart Aquarium in Golden Gate Park. Upon its completion, Steinhart lived in the hotel until his death in 1917. Personality Hotels purchased the property in 2000.

Renowned designer William Sofield of Studio Sofield, known for his design of the Soho Grand in Manhattan and Gucci stores around the world originally designed The Steinhart. In 2013 the lobby and one-bedroom apartments were renovated by Jonathan Rachman, giving the Steinhart a completely refreshed and modern aesthetic while keeping true to the original architecture and design.
