


A GUIDE TO **GLENDALE**, **CALIFORNIA**

Whether you prefer larger shopping destinations or stand-alone retail chains, Glendale has plenty of options for shopping. At The Americana at Brand (889 Americana Way, 1.6 miles), you can bask in Glendale's warm weather as you peruse stores like Barnes & Noble, Nordstrom and Chico's at this outdoor shopping destination. While there, you can ride the electric trolley around the property, or stroll through the grass and enjoy the sounds of

As one of the largest indoor shopping mall in L.A., the Glendale Galleria (100 W. Broadway #700, 1.6 miles) offers access to shops like Bloomingdale's, Brookstone, JC Penney and Macy's, among dozens of others. If you'd rather skip the large malls and get your shopping done at a discount retailer instead, you'll also have access to Target, Walmart and 99 Cents, which are all within a 5-mile radius of Windsor.

📜 DINING

With one of the country's largest Armenian populations, Glendale offers the chance to treat your taste buds to the best Middle Eastern cuisine in L.A. County. Start off with an authentic kabob at the casual Original Kabob Factory (1700 W. Glenoaks Blvd., Unit D, 4.9 miles) or sit down to a complete dining experience with the kabobs at Raffi's Place (211 E. Broadway, 1.5 miles), which earned top honors for Best Middle Eastern Cuisine in Los Angeles from Zagat in 2013. Don't forget dessert—baklava, of course—at the Baklava Factory (1415 E. Colorado St., 0.7 miles).

Glendale's two premier shopping destinations—The Americana at Brand and the Glendale Galleria also offer some of the city's best dining options. At The Americana at Brand, you can enjoy a meal at a familiar restaurant like The Cheesecake Factory or have an upscale dinner at the likes of Bourbon Steak by Michael Mina or Katsuya. If you're looking for fast casual dining, the Glendale Galleria houses chains like Chipotle, Blaze Pizza, Panda Express and Charley's Grilled Subs.



Nature surrounds Glendale, from the rugged peaks of the Verdugo Mountains along the skyline to the parks

sprinkled throughout the city. You'll find one of these green spaces—Windsor Mini-Park—just across the street from our Windsor community in Glendale.

Brand Park (1601 W. Mountain St., 5.5 miles) is also worth a visit. The 31-acre retreat with walking trails, a Japanese teahouse and Friendship Garden even has a library onsite. Plus, you'll be just 10 minutes from one of the largest urban parks in the country: Griffith Park (4730 Crystal Springs Drive, 5.0 miles), home to the Griffith Observatory, four golf courses and the famed Hollywood sign.

If the ocean breezes are calling your name, you'll find beaches like Santa Monica (23.3 miles) and Manhattan Beach (28.5 miles) in less than an hour's drive. Alternatively, you can head down to Long Beach (about an hour away) for whale-watching excursions during the summer and fall.

TOP ATTRACTIONS

In nearby Pasadena, Windsor residents enjoy visiting the Norton Simon Museum (411 W. Colorado Blvd., 5.6 miles) with its impressive collection of 14th- to 20th-century European paintings and sculptures. Residents can also take in the classical stylings of the Pasadena Symphony and POPS, which holds concerts throughout the year at Pasadena's Ambassador Auditorium (131 S. St. John Ave., 8 miles). Also not to be missed in Pasadena is the iconic Rose Bowl Stadium (1001 Rose Bowl Drive, 6.3 miles), host to monthly flea markets, UCLA football games and the annual Tournament of Roses.

In Los Angeles, the Autry National Center at Griffith Park (4700 Western Heritage Way, 3.5 miles) pays tribute to California's American West past through



ongoing lectures, film screenings and exhibits. Meanwhile, the Walt Disney Concert Hall (111 S. Grand Ave., 8.3 miles) is a treat for both eyes and ears, thanks to its stunningly distinctive architecture and the orchestra that calls it home: the Los Angeles Philharmonic. Also not too far is The Getty Center (1200 Getty Center Drive, 21.6 miles), a cultural retreat known for its impressive art exhibits, outdoor gardens and hilltop views of Los Angeles.

ENTERTAINING GRANDCHILDREN

Rest assured, grandchildren will be far from bored when it comes time to visit Glendale. The excitement of Universal Studios Hollywood (100 Universal City Plaza) is just 10 miles away, and the grandkids will never forget a tour of the backlot of this still-working film studio. The theme park brings favorite movies to life with its behind-the-scenes NBCUniversal Experience (an interactive exhibit featuring artifacts, wardrobe items and other props) and the Special Effects Stage, where youngsters can learn the studio secrets behind blockbuster films.

Educational opportunities abound in Los Angeles, too. About 20 minutes from Windsor, the California Science Center (700 Exposition Park Drive, 11.6 miles) lets the grandchildren get hands-on as they learn about science and technology through exhibits and an IMAX 3-D theater, as well as the space shuttle Endeavour. Another option for a funfilled afternoon with the family is the Los Angeles Zoo and Botanical Gardens (5333 Zoo Drive., 5.2 miles) at Griffith Park, home to roughly 1,200 rare and endangered species from around the world.
