Questions and Answers:

Q: Could I use a mix of Android and Apple devices, and could they be used at the same time?

A: Yes, you can use any combination of Android and Apple devices at the same time. The MimioMobile™ app supports iPad 2, iPad 3, iPad 4, iPad mini devices, iPhone (4th generation and higher), iPod Touch (4th generation and higher), and Android 3.0 (Honeycomb) tablets and smartphones. Q: Can I install the MimioMobile app on my smartphone and on iPad tablets?

A: Yes. With the MimioMobile app, you can use any combination of Android and Apple phones and tablets at the same time. The MimioMobile app supports iPad 2, iPad 3, iPad 4, iPad mini devices, iPhone (4th generation and higher), iPod Touch (4th generation and higher), and Android 3.0 (Honeycomb) tablets and smartphones.

Q: How do I use a QR code to connect the mobile devices used in my classroom to the MimioMobile app?

With the latest version of MimioStudio and MimioMobile, you can connect up to 50 mobile devices to take part in collaborative lessons and assessments.

Q: How do I use the MimioMobile app?

A: Using the MimioMobile app, students can interact individually with a lesson at the front of the room display when a teacher passes them control using the Control feature. This can be used with any student one at a time that has a MimioMobile enabled device. Using the Collaborate feature, the teacher can push out a complete interactive lesson page and give up to 50 students with mobile devices the ability to collaborate simultaneously using a limited tool set that includes a selection, pen, highlighter, undo/redo and eraser. Similarly, using the Quick Collaborate function, the teacher can enable a blank whiteboard screen for up to 50 student devices creating endless options for instruction and activities. Students can use MimioMobile enabled mobile devices to take assessments that include standard multiple choice, true-false, and open response questions that require essay, short answer and numeric responses. Q: Where is the MimioStudio™ Recorder found?

A: You can find this tool by clicking on the Applications button found on the Mimio floating toolbar.



Q: You mentioned a Class Manager, how do we get that from MimioStudio?

A: The Class Manager is found by clicking on the Applications button on the Mimio floating toolbar. You would also need to have set up your students in classes within the MimioStudio Gradebook before you could use the Class Manager to allow student mobile devices to connect. However, you could also use the Anonymous class without any setup. Using this option you wouldn't be able to collect any specific data from students.



The MimioStudio Gradebook is installed when you install the MimioStudio software. If you are using the MimioVote™ assessment and/or the MimioMobile app and want to collect data, you should use the MimioStudio Gradebook. You would initially set up the MimioStudio Gradebook with the roster of all students in a class. Each student is assigned a specific entry, so no matter what type of device they use – whether it is a MimioVote unit or MimioMobile-enabled mobile device – all data is collected properly. The software is designed to give classroom teachers flexibility in what technology they use in their classroom. Additionally, you can simply use the MimioStudio Gradebook as a stand-alone gradebook application if you need it for your classroom. Q: I'm having a hard time seeing how I could use the feature of connecting up to three mobile devices using the MimioMobile app, free with any MimioStudio license in a classroom of 30 kids. What suggestions do you have?

A: The great part is it gives the opportunity to try the MimioMobile app before buying it for your entire classroom. You can simply pass the MimioMobile enabled devices around to different students in a round-robin style, to have them all take part in the lesson activities. Using the MimioMobile app, you can push out a lesson page to student devices for collaboration to take place. Students can then complete the activity on the page. Students that don't have a mobile device can see what is taking place by watching the front of the room board where all the activities will be shown. This allows the teacher to observe what students are doing collectively in real time. You could even group your class into groups based upon the number of mobile devices you have. Then, have the students within the group pass the device around to complete individual objectives or activities. Just make sure you have the latest version of MimioStudio software installed on your teacher computer. If you decide that you want to enable more students to use the MimioMobile app, you will need to purchase a MimioMobile license.

Q: What is the cost for the MimioMobile app? Are there educator discounts?

A: An annual classroom license, which allows all mobile devices to connect to the teacher computer, is \$199. A school site license is \$2699. It is an annual license and it will expire after one year, once it's activated. If the license isn't renewed, it will revert back to the lite version, allowing you to use it with up to three mobile devices in your classroom at no cost. Q: Will Mimio lessons work on a Chromebook, Windows, or Kindle?

A: Currently, MimioStudio software is available for Windows, Mac, and Linux. Although the ability to install the software on other platforms such as Chromebook and Windows tablets is not currently available, it is part of our product plan for late 2015.



Q: I'm looking for ways to differentiate math using the MimioMobile app. What ideas do you have?

A: Using the MimioMobile app, your options are limitless. Depending on your instructional goals, you can do a variety of things to differentiate the instruction. You could have a lesson page with various activities on it. As you push this lesson page out to student mobile devices using the Collaborate mode, different students could work on different activities. Even more powerful, you can use the Quick Collaborate feature. You'll find this in the Applications button on the Mimio floating toolbar. This creates a blank page on each mobile device. You can then have your students work out any math problem whether it's from a textbook, worksheet, or one that you provide. The power of this tool is the blank page with access to a limited set of tools (pen, highlighter, eraser, undo/redo) that allows students to write, demonstrate, and model the skills. You can then pick and choose what students do as well as focus in on groups or students or individual students. You don't have to have an already designed lesson to make differentiation a possibility. Make whatever you do fit the needs of your classroom and students. Additionally, you can use the built-in features of MimioMobile during collaboration to pause all student devices or even hide what everyone can see on the front of room display. Q: How did you design the checkmarks to reveal the answers?

A: This particular checkmark reveal, as with most items like this, is a combination of items. For the check mark reveal demonstrated, you first must add your desired instructional elements either from the MimioStudio Gallery or any other resource. Once you create your object you want to click to reveal, you would then animate it. Do this by right-clicking and choose Animate, or Insert > Animate. You will then be able to select from a list of animations. If you want it to slide in as demonstrated, you'll select one of the "slide in from..." options. You can also then select one of the Triggers at the bottom. "Triggers" refers to the icon that will be attached to the text box that you'll click on. The three Triggers are Default (grey triangle icon), Results (graph icon), and Notes (question mark icon). We typically use the Notes option for objective boxes. Click OK to set it. If you click on the icon that was created, the object you animated will move into the position where you set it. You'll notice a blue border around the object. This indicates that it's an interactive element of your page, and you'll want to lock it to make the blue border go away. Select your newly animated object, right-click, and choose Lock or Format > Locking > Lock.

Q: How many teachers can use a license for the MimioMobile app?

A: When you install MimioStudio software on your teacher computer and it's activated by connecting any Mimio product, you can use the MimioMobile app with any mobile device in your classroom that connects with that one teacher computer. The license is per computer on which MimioStudio software is installed. If every teacher has MimioStudio software installed on his or her computer and uses a Mimio product, they all can make immediate use of the MimioMobile app in their classroom.



Q: In these lesson samples, are students using the Mimio stylus or mobile devices to interact?

A: Depending on your instructional goals, both methods could be used. You could have students come to the front of the room and interact with lesson elements on the screen. You could then also switch it up and either give individual students control to complete activities on individual mobile devices or push the lesson out to all mobile devices in a collaborative activity. Using the MimioMobile app, you have many options to utilize.

Q: How do I show the students working on the screen? Is there a maximum number that can be shown?

A: When using the Collaborate mode with MimioMobile enabled mobile devices, each individual student's mobile device will show on the front-of-room display. You can have up to 50 students collaborating at the same time. With the new features available in the MimioMobile app, you can choose to hide the screen at the front of the room, pause activity, and select any number of student mobile devices to be shown on the screen. Q: I have MimioStudio Notebook. I keep hearing about the MimioTeach. How are they different?

A: Great questions! MimioStudio Notebook is the actual software that runs on your computer. Using the software, you can open and create your own interactive lessons to use in your classroom. You can also open any already prepared lesson files from other teachers or from our teacher community, [MimioConnect](#). The MimioTeach™ interactive whiteboard is our flagship portable interactive whiteboard product. It's an interactive bar that magnetically attaches to any existing whiteboard or flat surface you have in your classroom. Using the MimioTeach along with the MimioStudio software, you instantly transform your regular whiteboard into an interactive teaching tool. Q: How do I become a member of MimioConnect?

Q: How do I start to create lessons like the ones shown?

A: The goal is to try to think interactively when using existing lessons or developing your own. Start with a concept you want to teach. You might take a textbook concept and think about how to make it interactive for your students. Start simply with the concept itself, and add text and graphic components. Build in interactivity by adding pull-outs, sorting activities, reveals from the Gallery, and animations. Beginning like this will help the lesson continue to develop. Remember that you don't have to start from scratch. Use the "insert file" ability of MimioStudio software to insert your existing Word, PDF, and PowerPoint files right into the software, and then add a few elements to make them interactive. Q: Can you use the MimioMobile app on laptop computers?

A: Although you can install and run MimioStudio software on student laptops for them to use, the MimioMobile app is designed only for mobile devices. Only a teacher laptop running MimioStudio software and the licensed MimioMobile features will be able to interact with student mobile devices that have the MimioMobile app. Student laptops will not be able to use the Collaborate features as they would on a mobile device, since this is not how the app was designed or intended to be used. In order to use the MimioMobile license, the teacher's computer must have MimioStudio software installed. In addition, student mobile devices and a teacher mobile device have to be enabled with the free MimioMobile app to be able to interact throughout the classroom.

Q: We have a computer lab for students to use. Can I have students use lessons on the computers?

A: The MimioStudio software can be used on Mac, PC, and Linux computers, and you can install the software on any computer you or your students use. They can use the free limited version to create, open, and manipulate MimioStudio lesson files.

Q: Can I add an mp4 or other documents (Word, PDF, etc) to MimioStudio and then use the tools that are available.

A: This is one of the most valuable features of the MimioStudio software that allows you to use your existing lesson resources without reinventing. You can insert Word documents, PDFs, PowerPoint files, images, audio, videos, Flash files, and other interactive whiteboard files. Simply click on the Insert > File button in the top menu. Browse to the resource located on your computer. The file will be inserted into the MimioStudio software giving you the power to use any of the MimioStudio tools as well as add your own interactive elements to the lesson. You may need third-party codec files installed on your computer in order for certain files to be utilized. Download [Windows](#) and [Mac](#) video codec packs. As an alternative, you can also hyperlink to any file resource you have on your computer from MimioStudio software. The benefit of this is that the file will open in the native program that your computer typically uses. Learn more [about formatting objects and adding hyperlinks](#). Q: How much time did it take our presenters to remake these lessons?

A: Claire and Lindy indicate it took them 2-4 hours. Part of this time involved a little research if it was outside their content area. This will obviously vary based upon your experience level with the MimioStudio software and your goals you have for a lesson. Starting from scratch, a lesson involving slides with interactive activities, assessment options, and other content may involve an hour or less, but you want to build multiple activities for students to become engaged. As a beginner, you can expect to take more time as you learn formatting techniques and how to achieve your objectives for a lesson. Once you have your files set up, future use of these only require tweaking as you save these files electronically. There are many ways to start very quick using content you already have such as files from Microsoft Word, PowerPoint, and PDFs. These file types including sound, video, and other interactive whiteboard files can easily be inserted into the MimioStudio software. This gives you a quick starting point to make lesson more interactive using the software. Add to that the number of resources available on the MimioConnect community and you'll find you can get started very quickly without having to necessarily reinvent the wheel.

Q: Are certificates available for the on-demand webinars?
