



MimioStudio 11 Beta

Features

1. PowerPoint object-level import

- Available from the File->Open menu in MimioStudio™ Notebook.
- Supported on Windows only, using PowerPoint 2010 or above.
- Imports all objects from the original PowerPoint file into the Notebook as objects.
 - If the Notebook doesn't support the type of object, the object is imported as an image.

2. Animations

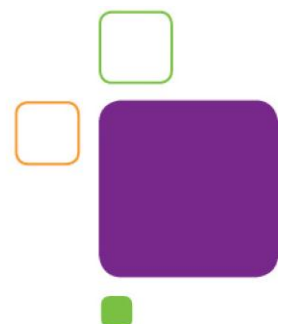
- Available from the Insert->Animate menu or the context menu of a selected object in Notebook.
- Types
 - Slide In (from 8 locations)
 - Slide Out (from 8 locations)
 - Fade In
 - Fade Out
 - Shrink
 - Grow

3. Enhanced Collaborate

- Available from the Main Toolbar or the Tools->Collaborate menu item in Notebook.
 - Also available from the right-click context menu on either the main page or a selected page in the Thumbnails view.
- Provides Collaborate functionality using the contents of a page (i.e., an activity).
- Original Collaborate functionality (with a blank page) is now called Quick Collaborate, and is available from the Mimio Tools, Applications button and the right-click context menu of the task tray icon.
 - This functionality can also be accomplished by launching Collaborate with a blank page in the Notebook.
- Remember that all Collaborative Sessions are stored in MimioStudio Gallery.
- Supported for both MimioPad™ wireless pen tablets and MimioMobile™ v2 app.

4. Short Answer/Numeric/Essay Vote Objects

- Available from the Gallery under the Questions and Results section.
- Supported only through the use of MimioMobile v2 app (this question type will not work with MimioVote™ handsets).
- **You will not be able to use this feature until the latest version of the MimioMobile app is released to the App Store.**





Known Issues

- A file created using MimioStudio 11 software with either the new vote object (short answer, numeric, or essay) or with animations will not open in previous versions. If you save a file in MimioStudio 11 software without the vote object or animations, the file will open in MimioStudio 9 and 10 software.
- The PowerPoint object-level import functionality is supported on Windows for PowerPoint 2010 and later. If you are using a previous version of PowerPoint or are running on the Mac or Linux platform, each slide will be imported as a background image.
- A few PPTX files (i.e., those that contain equations) might fail to import correctly with PowerPoint 2013. If you encounter a file that doesn't work, please send the file to the Beta address (mimiobeta@mimio.com).
- Animations are not recommended on Choice Pool objects in ActivityWizard.
- Some stroke objects (i.e., those created using the Brush tool) may look choppy when you apply a Fade In animation.
- After polling with the short answer or numeric vote object, all the available answers may not be displayed. If you click on the object, you will see a scroll bar displayed and can scroll through the answers.
