BONNER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

REQUIREMENTS

- Bonner Scholars must complete 140 hours of unpaid community service, training and enrichment each semester (about 8-10 hours/week) for a non-profit organization.
- Bonner Scholars must complete two summers of 280 hours of community service each summer with a non-profit organization. They may be paid for their summer service hours and work in their hometown.
- Bonner Scholars must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0.
- Bonner Scholars must participate in training and enrichment activities such as meetings, reflections and retreats.

FAST FACTS

- The Bonner Scholarship is funded by a private foundation, The Bonner Foundation, located in Princeton, NJ.
- Waynesburg University is one of only two universities in the state of Pennsylvania that offers this program.
- There are only 21 Bonner Scholar schools in the entire country.

SCHOLARSHIP

- The Bonner Scholarship is a four-year scholarship program.
- Bonner Scholars receive \$2,500 each year (\$1,250 for the Fall semester and \$1,250 for the Spring semester). This money is used to offset direct educational expenses.
- Bonner Scholars receive \$1,000 for a living stipend while completing their summer service.
- After completing their summer service requirements, Bonner Scholars receive an additional \$1,500 per year (\$750 for the fall semester and \$750 for the spring semester). This money is used to offset direct educational expenses.
- Upon graduation, Bonner Scholars who have completed all scholarship requirements receive a \$2,000 loan reduction. If the student does not have any loans, the money may be used for graduate school.
- In addition to the Bonner Scholarship, students may be eligible to receive additional federal, state and/or institutional aid.
