An Introduction to Surrogacy

A guide for women considering becoming surrogates



What is surrogacy?

Gestational surrogacy is an arrangement in which a woman carries a child to term for intended parents who are unable to have children on their own. She is known as a gestational surrogate or gestational carrier.

Intended parents create fertilized embryos through in vitro fertilization, sometimes with the assistance of an egg donor or sperm donor. These embryos are cultivated in a laboratory and implanted in the surrogate.



Gestational surrogates have no genetic relationship to the children they carry. By contrast, **traditional surrogates** are both *gestational carriers and genetic contributors*, becoming pregnant by artificial insemination, and carrying the child to term for the intended parents.

Circle Surrogacy currently facilitates only gestational surrogacy arrangements.

Who can become a surrogate?

<u>Requirements for surrogate</u> applicants vary from agency to agency. Wondering if you qualify? Circle surrogates must meet the following guidelines:

- Between 21 41 years of age
- Delivery of a healthy child within past 10 years
- Body Mass Index no higher than 32
- Residence in a U.S. state other than WA, NE, MI, NY, NJ, or the District of Columbia.
- No illegal drugs, cigarettes, or alcohol abuse
- No current use of anti-depressants
- Women with IUDs are welcome to apply, though additional qualification requirements may arise that may affect a projected timeline
- No more than 2 previous c-sections

Working with an agency provides you with full service support and guidance throughout the entire process.

How much do surrogates make?

At Circle Surrogacy, the fees to a gestational surrogate can start anywhere from \$22,500 to \$29,000 . This is called the **base fee** and does not include additional compensation for various expenses and reimbursements such as travel, maternity clothes, transfer fees and lost wages/bed rest.
