My second daughter would have grown up in an institution without parents or siblings. She may or may not

have had the opportunity to go to school. She certainly would not have had the opportunity to learn Karate, play baseball, read the classics, spend the night with a friend, giggle at her sister's jokes, and become anything she wishes. She makes living fun. My son would have been raised in extreme poverty on the streets of an unsafe city possibly without any parents. Are you willing to expand your family's cultural identity? Are you prepared to provide a child with a forever family? If you answered yes, please consider sharing your love with a child waiting for a family.
