To: All AVPC Users who observe Daylight Savings  
 From: Adaptive's Support Team  
 Subject: Daylight Savings changes for 2007 and beyond.

As you may know starting this year the United States has changed the dates for Daylight Savings. The AVPC must be patched to handle the new dates.

To patch the AVPC to handle the new dates do the following:

1. Unzip the attached **TZupdate.zip** file
2. Copy the **TZupdate.reg** file to the AVPC
3. Establish a remote connection the AVPC with either VNC or Remote Desktop
4. Browse to the **TZupdate.reg** file
5. Double-Click on the **TZupdate.reg** file
6. It will ask you if you are sure you want to add it to the Registry – Click **Yes**
7. It will say that it was successfully entered – Click **OK**
8. Open the Control Panel
9. Double-Click on the **Date/Time** icon
10. Make sure the “Automatically adjust clock for daylight savings changes” is checked
11. Click on the **Time Zone** tab
12. Change the Time Zone to something else – Click **Apply**
13. Change the Time Zone back to what it is supposed to be – Click **OK**

The AVPC is now patched

The new dates are displayed in Table 1.
