Frost and Sullivan predicts the patient portal market will reach almost **\$900 million by 2017**, up from \$280 million in 2012—a **three-fold increase**



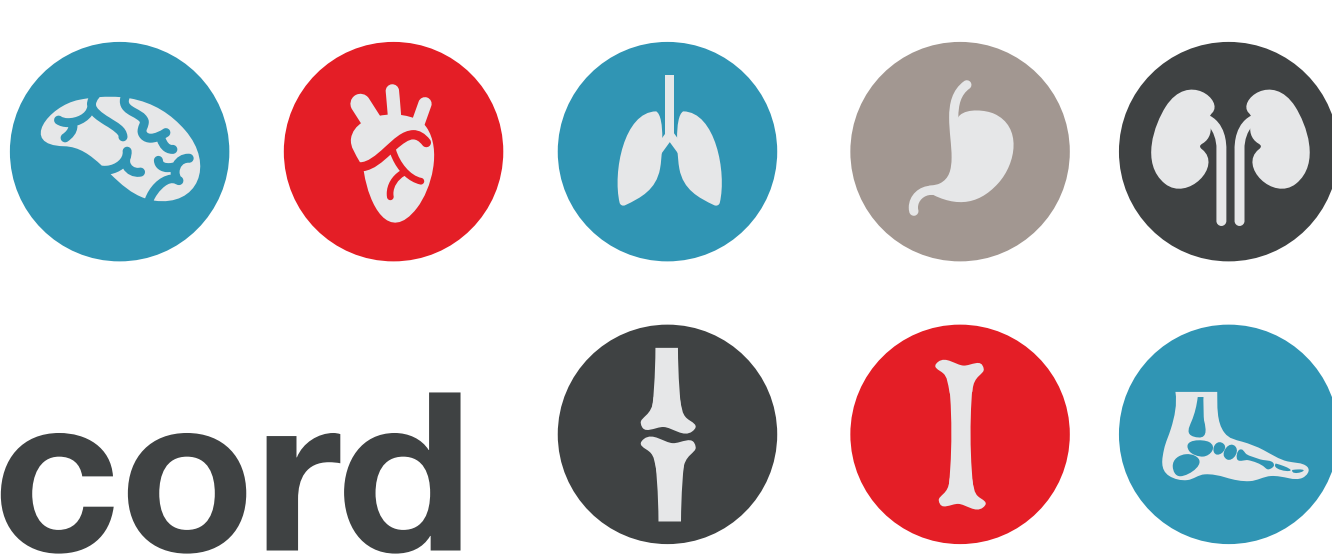
