TOP TEN TERMITE QUESTIONS

Q. My home is fairly new, could I get termites?

A. Yes, termites can be existing in the lumber used to build your home. Termites can exist in the soil where the home is built on.

Q. How do termites get into my house?

A. Termites swarm twice a year. Subterranean termites swarm during the rainy season and drywood termites swarm mid to late summer. There have been times when termites swarmed in an unexpected time of the year.

Q. Do termites and ants look the same?

A. It is often difficult to determine the difference between the two. The chart below points out the three key differences.

Q. Do I always need to fumigate my house if termites are found?

A. No, if subterranean termites are found, treating the soil will be required. Drywood termites can be spot treated and we also use a specialized scope so we can see into wall voids around the area of visible evidence. There are times where the primary recommendation will be to fumigate the structure.

Q. Do I have to leave my house when the termite treatment are being done?

A. Most of the time you do not need to leave your home when treatments are being done. There are products that have a minimal impact on the environment and also organic products are used.

Q. My neighbor is having their home home treated for termites, should I have my home checked for termites?

A. Termites in your neighbors home doesn't always mean you also have termites. Termites can be present in your home for years but have not been seen, Having your home inspected is always a way to help prevent major damage and extreme cost.
