OSHA General Safety Programs Fire Extinguisher Training Satisfies 29 CFR 1910.157

testing of portable fire extinguishers provided for the use of

employees.

Prerequisites: None

Frequency and Duration: This training program requires up to 2 hours to complete. A

refresher program is required on an annual basis.

Purpose and Overview:

Applicability:

- Safe Use of Extinguishers and methods of fire extinguishment.
- Demonstrate the appropriate use of fire equipment to employees who have been designated to use firefighting equipment as part of the company's emergency action plan.
- Hands on use of fire extinguisher on a live fire in a controlled environment.
