- 350 randomly selected owners & managers
 - . Conducted July 25 August 12, 2013
- Sample reflects Minnesota's business community
 - . Size
 - . Location
 - . Business category retail, service, manufacturing
- Margin of error ± 5.3 percent







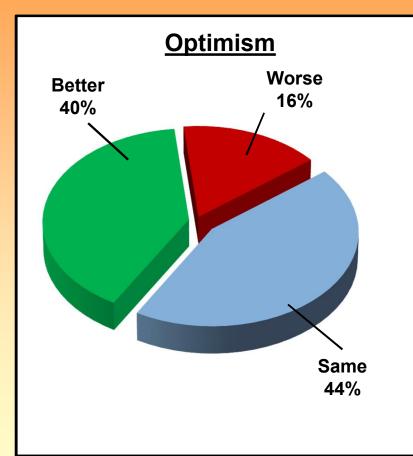

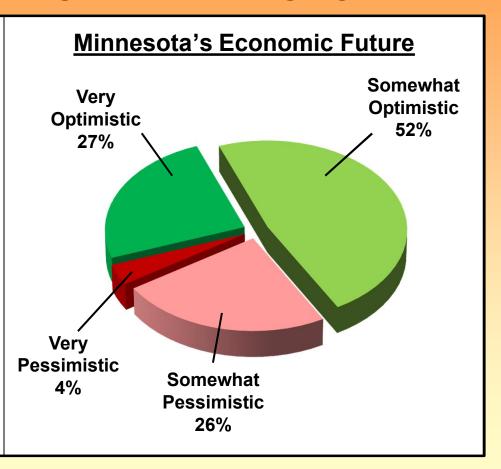

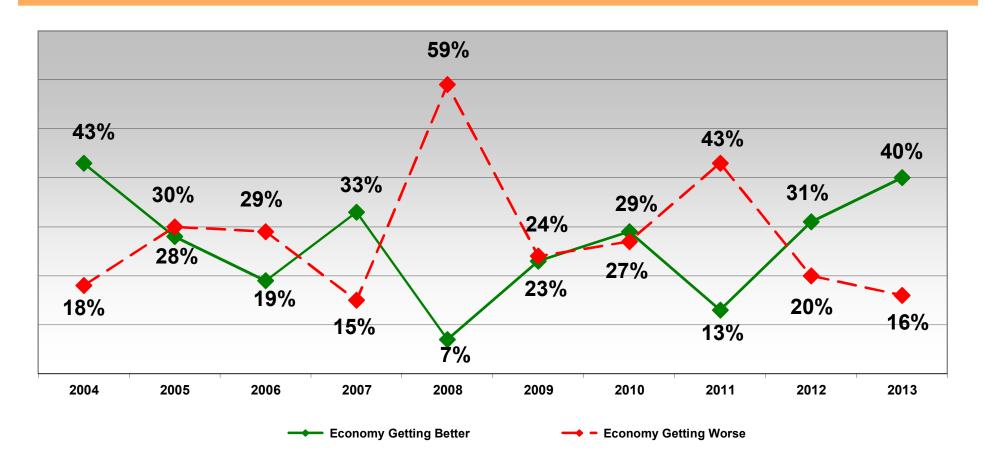








Optimism About Economy Has Improved

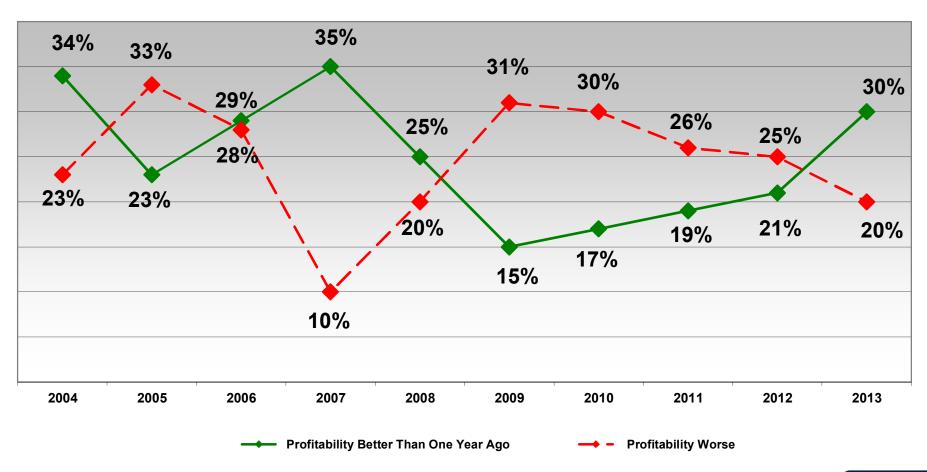








Profitability Nearing 2007 Levels

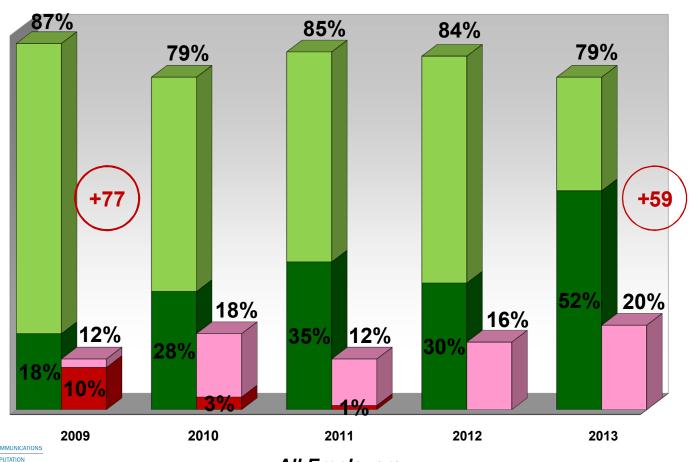








Confidence In Minnesota's Economic Future (10 Yrs) Remains High



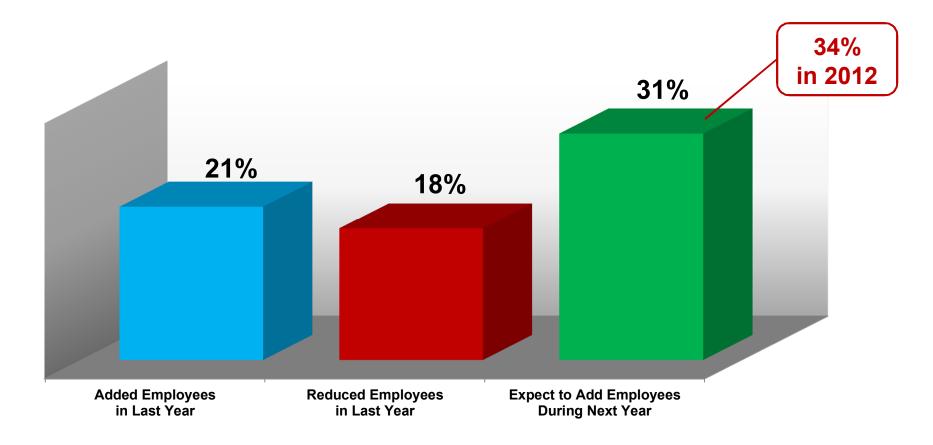

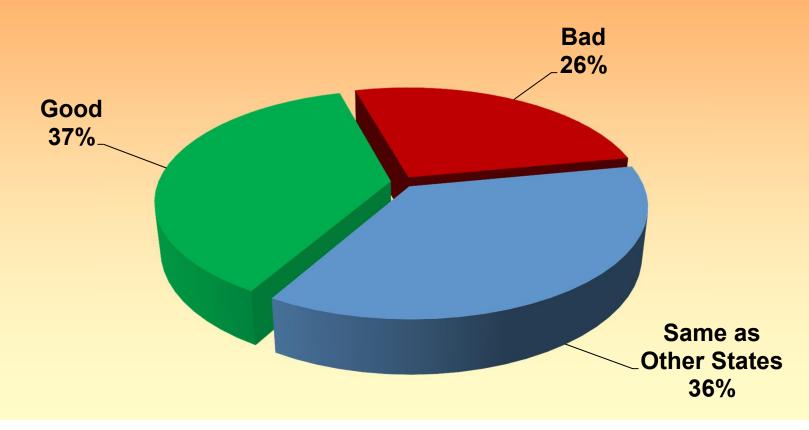

Minnesota's Business Climate Compared to Other States

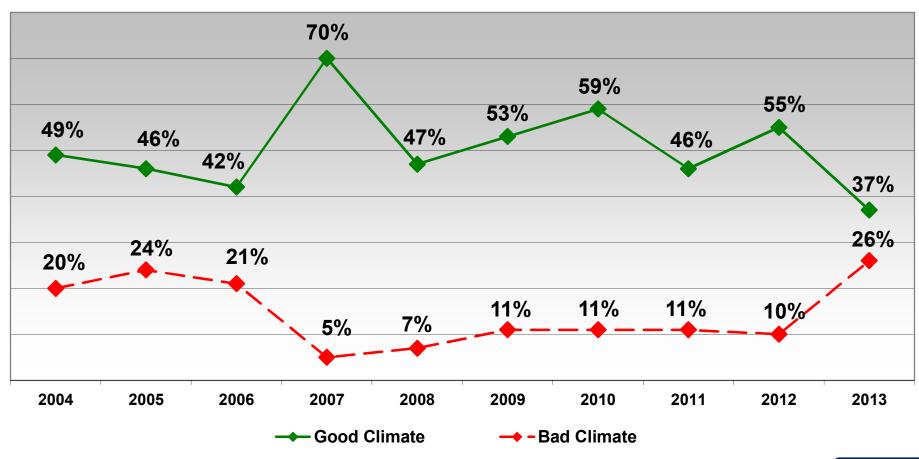








Record Low Business Climate Numbers





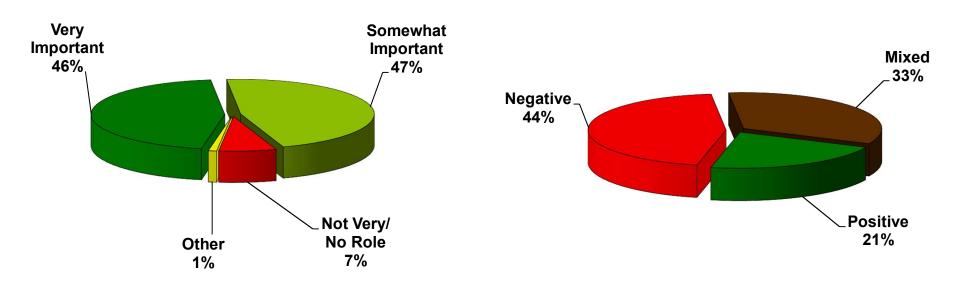




Employers Continue To Believe St. Paul Can Do More

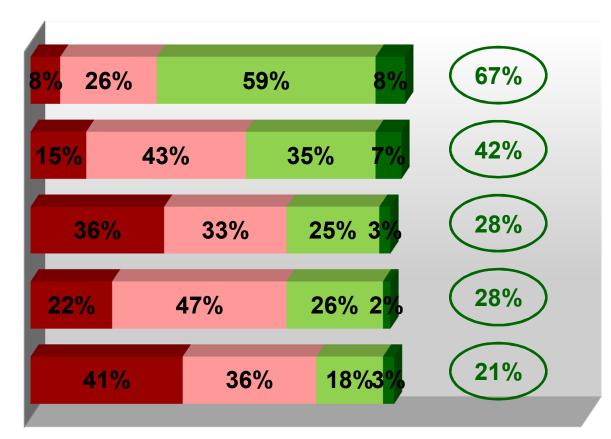

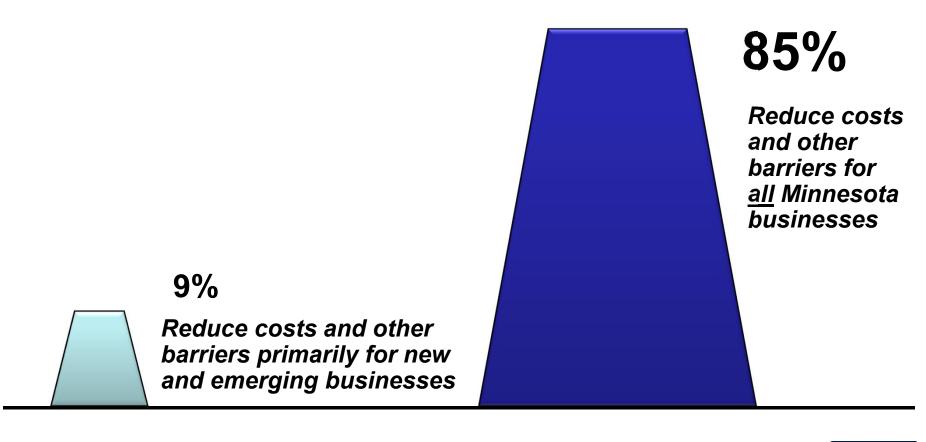

Knowledge Gap: Do Legislators Understand Business?

Do Elected Officials Understand Our Challenges?

Strongly Yes – 3% Yes – 30%

No – 42% Strongly No – 23%

In 2013, Legislature was:

- More positive toward business 7%
- More negative 23%
- No real change 54%

Why don't legislators understand?

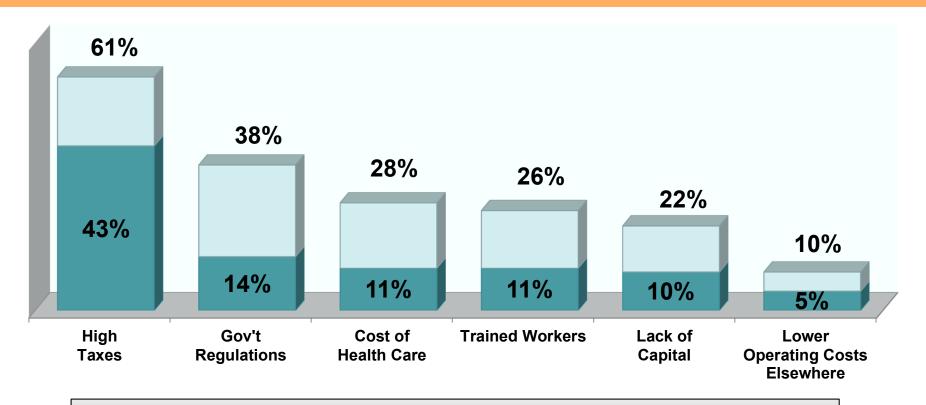
- They don't understand business basics – 18%
- They don't understand how gov't gets in the way – 78%

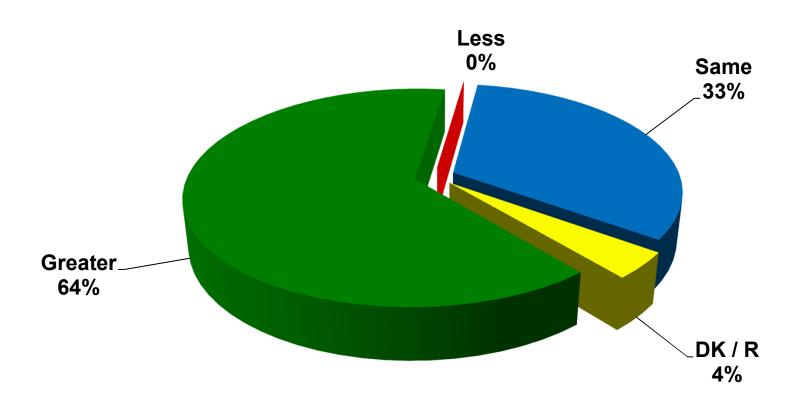

Tax Burden Continues To Grow Compared To Five Years Ago

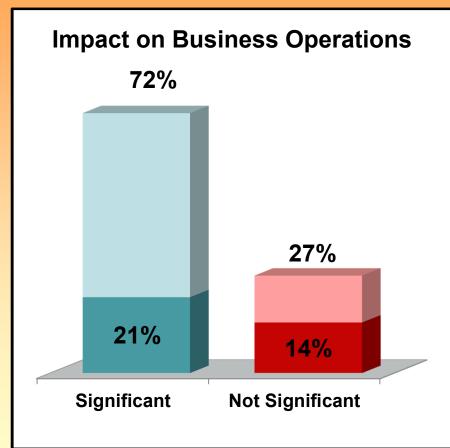








Effect of Fourth Tier Income Tax



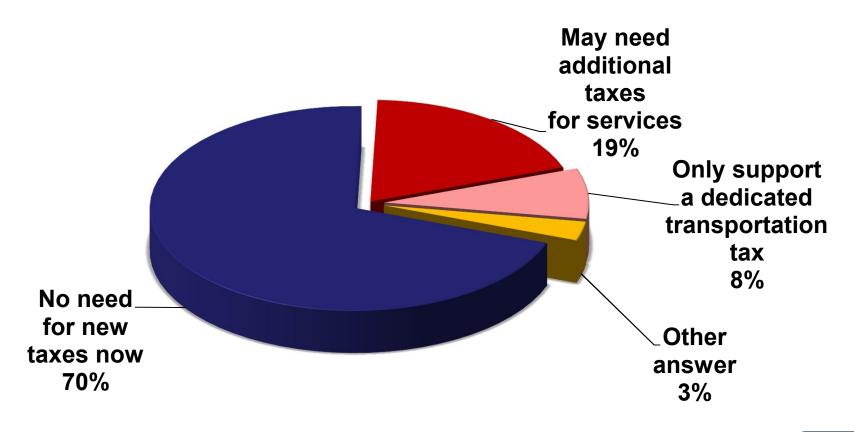








Dedicated Taxes Fail to Win Business Support

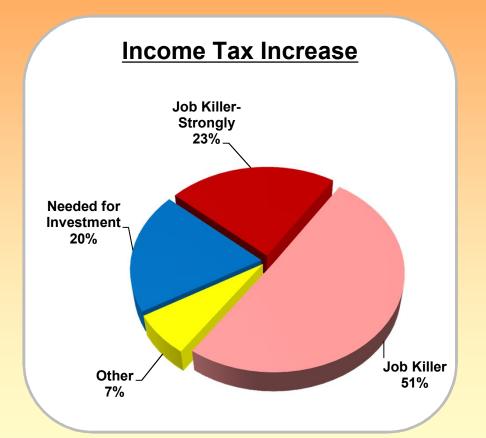


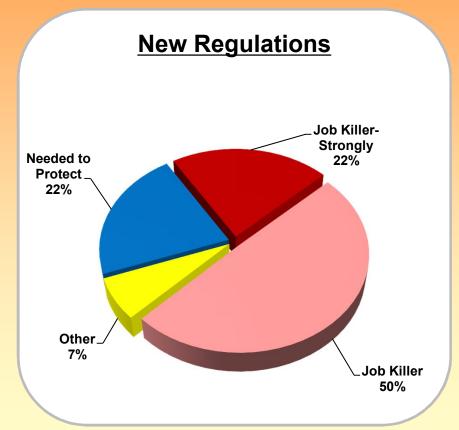






Business Views Taxes, Regulations Similarly





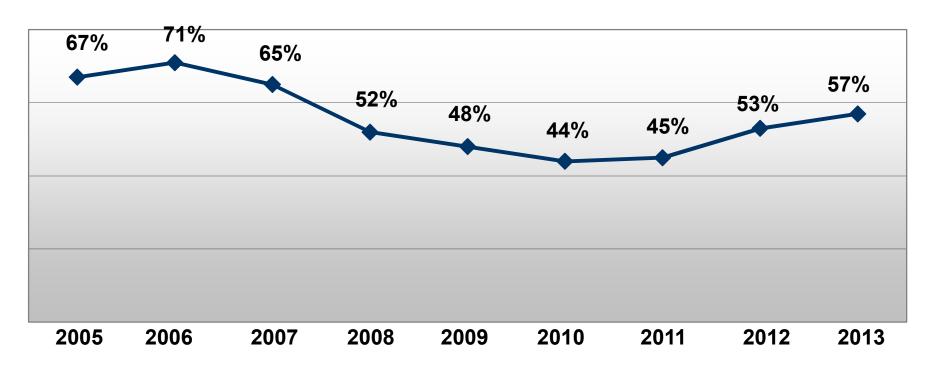






Use Of Health Insurance As A Benefit

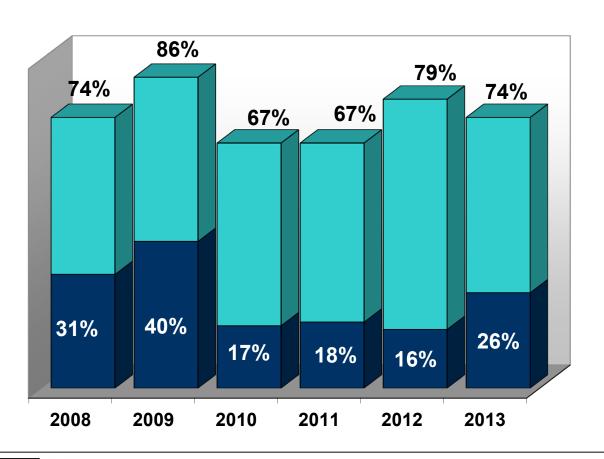








For Those Who Offer Coverage, Costs Are Increasing

82% say it makes <u>no</u> difference that MN has its own exchange

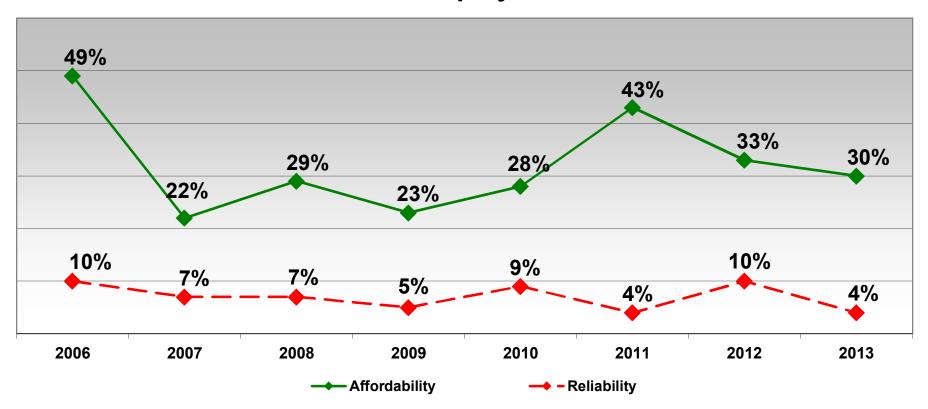

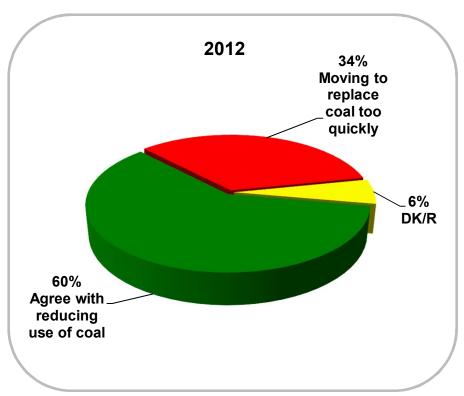


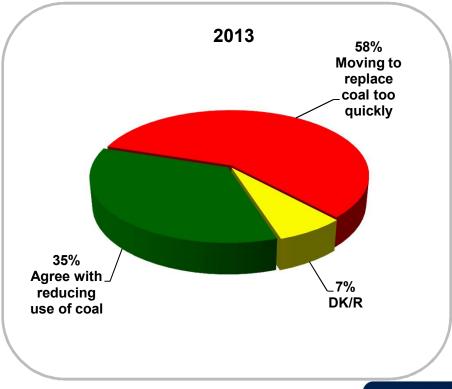




Coal Bounces Back

Commitment To Continued Use Of Coal











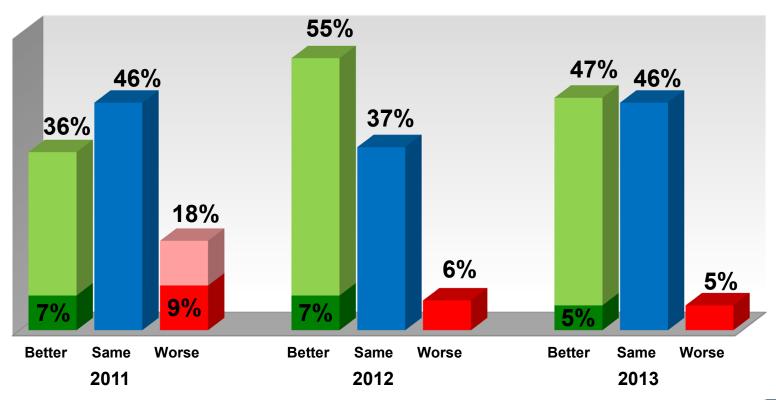

Enough workers, but not properly trained 29%

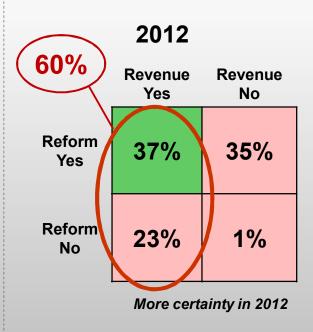


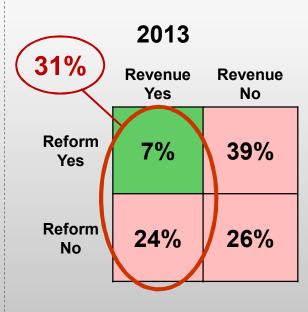




Support For New Revenue Weakens
