*This location will feature "Hands On" commercial & recreational boating survival techniques and a display of public safety vessels At the Green Harbor Town Pier, the US Coast Guard will once again be available with the following:

- ◇ CG P-6 dewatering pumps on display and for operational use.
- ◇ USCG fishing vessel examiners will be on hand to answer questions.
- ◇ Collection site for expired flares
- ◇ Schedule a free Commercial fishing vessel or Charter boat exam.
- ◇ The USCG will be teaming up with The Fishing Partnership Support Services by providing in water immersion suit (**bring your own survival gear to actively participate in this training**) and life raft training as well as training on damage control and how to prepare for emergency situations in a controlled environment.
