

MedicsDocAssistant[™] EHR for Behavioral Health: Special Features for Behavioral Health Organizations

In addition to the MedicsDocAssistant EHR for Behavioral Health's (BH) capabilities for handling general BH requirements as overviewed in "MedicsDocAssistant EHR for Behavioral Health," the system is also feature-rich with the capacity to handle the very special needs of larger outpatient BH organizations.

These organizations typically contain multiple providers ranging from MDs to counselors and providers covering the overall BH spectrum. Very often, these centers employ over 100 providers serving thousands of patients over multiple locations.

Programs generally involve long term care covering Psychiatric Evaluations, Medication Management, and individual / group / family psychotherapy.

Documentation standards are rigid, usually revolving around compliance requirements that are state-specific and payer-dependent.

A typical document flow for a large BH facility includes documents as shown below. Individualized document flows for children and adults are generally required, with documentation driving the periodic audits that organizations face.




