



## **DESIGN-BUILD DELIVERY - EDUCATION AND TRAINING SESSIONS for Water and Wastewater Infrastructure Projects**

A “NEW” Workshop – Planning, Procurement and Managing a Design-Build Project

**Sessions Length** - Either a four or six hour program (can be expanded depending upon project or needs) A good class size is 12-20 attendees with representation of procurement, legal and operations and maintenance. We encourage inviting other agencies and public officials that could be involved in either the current or future projects to attend your session.

### **WDBC Programs**

- Produced with the input of utility and agency managers throughout the US, who have told us “what they need to know” in order to be prepared to handle both regular and emergency issues related to water infrastructure projects.
- Participants receive (and use) the WDBC Municipal Water and Wastewater Design-Build Handbook and additional handout materials

- A CEU certificate issued to attendees who complete a short 10 question multiple-choice test.
