Dordan to Expand its Bio Resin Show N Tell Display at Pack Expo Chicago

Pack Expo is produced by PMMI, which is a trade association with more than 560 members representing packaging material manufacturers, converters, machinery suppliers and service providers across the packaging supply chain.

Chicago, IL—October 28, 2012—Dordan Manufacturing Company Inc. expands its Bio Resin Show N Tell display at Pack Expo 2012, booth #8005. First unveiled at Pack Expo 2010, the Show N Tell consisted of four bio-based/biodegradable/compostable resins (PLA, PLA + starch, PHA, Cellulose Acetate) converted via thermoforming with associated specs, environmental profiles and cost comparative provided. At Pack Expo Las Vegas the following year, Dordan added two new materials to the display, Klöckner Pentaplast's TerraPET® and Microgreen Polymers' Aeris InCycle: The first allows customers to replace fossil fuel based material with up to 30% plant based material; the second is an expanded/foamed RPET with impressive sustainability implications due to lightweight.

This year, Dordan expands its Bio Resin Show N Tell, showing a representative of the polymer-base/mineral filled composites family and DPET, a material marketed as consuming less energy during extrusion than its PET counterpart; also of consideration is the much-anticipated "algae-plastic," which utilizes algae from waste water runoff as the polymers' bio-based feedstock. Lastly, Dordan's popular 100% PC RPET will be on display, demonstrating yet another approach to sustainable materials management.

Dordan CEO Daniel Slavin explains, "We have found a lot of interest in these 'environmentally friendly' materials and with more and more being developed, we feel it is important to provide our clients with all the information so they can make informed decisions that may help them achieve their definition of sustainable packaging."
