The New Orleans Model of assessment and treatment has been designed for intervention with families where there are child protection concerns. This well-established method for assessment utilises standardised measures in order to evaluate the level of risk and ensure that appropriate intervention is put in place as quickly as possible.

11.45. *"You Never Can Tell: Looking at the New Orleans Model in Practice."*

Christine Puckering, Clinical Psychologist, NSPCC, Glasgow and Mellow Parenting. This case presentation will describe work with a family, beginning with the initial assessment and the subsequent collaboration with the social workers involved. The aims of treatment will be linked to the different components of the assessment, and the course of treatment illustrated.

14.00. *"Measuring parent-infant interaction: the Parent-Infant Relational Assessment Tool (PIRAT)."*

Carol Broughton. Child Psychotherapist, Anna Freud Centre, London.

PIRAT provides a global rating of interactions between parent and infant in order to evaluate the quality of the relationship, and it includes assessing both positive behavior and areas of concern. This can be applied to toddlers up to the age of two.

15.10. *"The Keys to Interactive Parenting Scale: A video-based method of parenting assessment and planning interventions."*

Robin Balbernie. Child Psychotherapist, Secure Start, Cheltenham.

The KIPS method of assessing the quality of interaction between a caregiver and child is based on analyzing 12 different aspects of behavior that can be observed in a short period of filmed play. This can be scored for evaluating interventions. It can be applied for children between the ages of 2 to 71 months, and pinpoints both strengths and needs.
