- & replace the batteries in both the smoke & carbon monoxide detectors twice a year. If your detectors are wired to your home's electrical system, do a manual check several times a year.

# Quick Tips!

<u>Safety Tip</u>: To evaluate how secure your home really is, pretend that you have locked yourself out. How would you get in if you had to? Walk around your home \$ look for entry points that do not present too much difficulty. These are the areas that should be given more security from burglars. Make a list of windows & doors that need extra security ¢ make these a priority.

Green Living Tip: If you love magazine & newspaper subscriptions, but don't like having so many items to recycle, consider sharing subscriptions with your friends, family, or neighbors. Decide on subscriptions that you are both interested in ¢ then split the cost. Once you or your friend is done with the magazine or newspaper, simply pass it on. This is not only good for the environment, but it will save you money too!

If you have an iPad you can also subscribe to magazines & newspapers through an app which downloads right to your tablet, eliminating paper entirely.

## Make Sure Your Smoke Alarms Protect You!

Do you have at least one smoke alarm in your house? If not, you and your family are twice as likely not to survive a serious house fire than if you had smoke detectors.

But, even if you do have smoke alarms, you and your family could still be at great risk. Smoke alarms can give you a false sense of security unless you do the following:

- $\checkmark$  Buy smoke alarms that have the seal of approval from an independent testing firm such as Underwriters Laboratories (UL).
- ✓ Your house should have at least one smoke alarm on each level—and preferably one outside each bedroom.
- ✓ You should test your smoke alarms at least once a month—follow the manufacturer's instructions-and replace the batteries in the smoke alarms at least twice a year.
- ✓ Make certain everyone in your family can recognize the sound of the smoke alarm, and make sure they understand it's critically important to act immediately if they hear it.
- ✓ Plan at least two escape routes from every room in the house. Make sure every family member understands and practices the escape routes from his/her bedroom and from all the common use rooms in the house.
- ✓ Got guests? Make sure they know how to get out of their bedrooms—especially children. You might just save the life of a guest who would otherwise be totally disoriented in your home in the event of an emergency.
