# The Hauswirth Report Turn Your Life Into Shreds!

Recently, one of our sons told me he received a Sears credit card in the mail. Problem is, he never asked for it. When he called the Customer Service Office at Sears they not only thanked him for being a new customer, they told him he had a \$4,800 balance on the temporary card they gave him at the store the week before. How did it happen? He does not know, but chances are it was some old papers that were tossed out in the garbage without being properly disposed of.

## How Much is Your Personal Data Security Worth?

Probably a lot more than \$4,800 and a lot more than the cost of a small sized paper shredder. These small shredding machines can shred a lot of paper that you no longer need and it would take only a few minutes a day.

Every piece of paper that has your name and address on it (or even worse, an

account number or financial institution) is pure gold in the hands of a forger/crook. Do you ever get unsolicited offers from lending institutions that says you are "preapproved" for a credit card or line of credit? This too is valuable in the hands of a crook. In many instances, crooks have been able to piece together the torn up credit card application form and fraudulently apply for the card in the victim's name.

## Don't Think it Could Happen to You?

These things are happening every day, whether with the improper handling of paper or data theft online (data tracking and data theft). More and more folks are tossing

personal data into their garbage can or in the recycling depots. **Tearing up documents by hand is not the solution either**; it's time consuming and, unless done carefully, it will not accomplish what you want.

#### Bring On The Shredder!

If you are donating magazines, tear out the address details or blacken it

with a marker pen. For the rest, <u>bring</u> on the <u>shredder</u>! With most documents, there is probably only 1-2 pages that have your personal information that needs to be shredded, so you don't need to destroy everything and the rest can be recycled.

Like you, Margareth and I have accumulated tons of documents we needed to properly dispose of: outdated customer files, tax documents that we kept past their "keep until" date, payroll records, and old accounting records. The shredded paper is then compacted and, each week, shipped to a paper manufacturer where it is converted into paper towels.

Our next shredding day will be Thursday, October 17 from 12 noon until 2 p.m. We will be opening up this spe-

cial service for our customers and will offer you the chance to toss out your old data sensitive papers to be shredded by our folks (Guardian Shredding) for <u>free</u>.
