[Box Inc.](#)

Box Inc. is a secure, enterprise-focused online file sharing and storage solution. It can be accessed from your iPhone, iPad and on the web from your desktop computer.



[CamCard](#)

CamCard is a mobile business card transcription service that transcribes your business cards and creates phone contacts for you.



[Evernote](#)

Evernote is an easy-to-use app for organizing notes that you don't want to lose or forget. A "note" can be a piece of formatted text, a webpage, a photograph, a voice memo, etc. Notes can have file attachments and are even searchable.



[AroundMe](#)

On a work trip and need to find the closest bank or post office? This app will find it for you, including its distance from your location and where to find it on Google Maps.



[Dragon Dictation](#)

This voice recognition app allows you to "write" a speech, email or text 5x faster than typing it.



[Cisco WebEx: Virtual meeting](#)

With the Cisco WebEx Meeting Center app, you can attend a WebEx conference wherever you are.



[Scanner Pro](#)

Scanner Pro turns your iPhone or iPad into a portable scanner for documents, receipts, notes, photos, etc. It can adjust the image quality, make PDFs and more.

Square Register allows nonprofits to receive payments through any iPad, iPhone or Android device. A small, portable card reader plugs into your mobile device's headphone jack to allow you to scan credit cards. Payments are securely sent directly to your organization's bank account.

Organizations can list volunteer opportunities on VolunteerMatch and request individuals or groups with certain talents, skills or interests.
