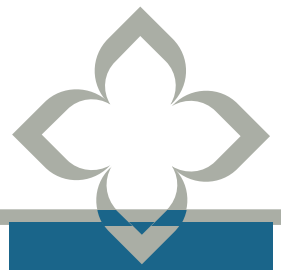

Stock Market

Nativity 8th grade math teacher, Karen Gruenke, recently partnered with CLLE to enhance her students' study of the stock market. The students have been participating in a UC economic education program. They were "given" \$100,000 to invest over a 12-week period. Deupree House resident, Mr. Ted Sarran, a broker with more than 50 years of experience, was the perfect candidate to share his knowledge of the stock market with these first time investors.

Mr. Sarran discussed how the stock market was established. He reviewed a chart displaying Dow milestones over the past several years and provided Fortune magazine's list of the 50 most admired companies. The students were intrigued with
