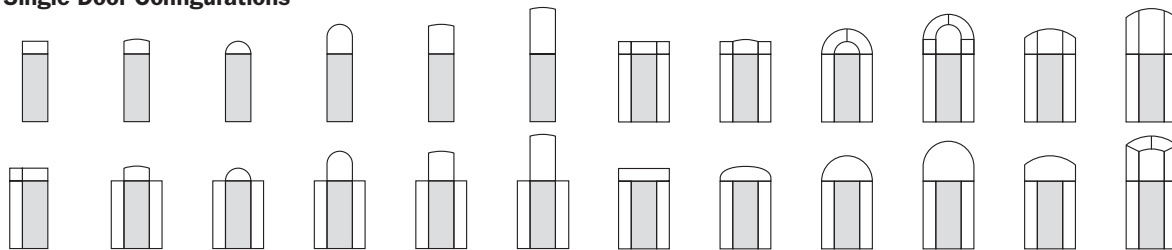
### Sidelights & Transoms

These charts demonstrate the range of configurations available for rectangular single and double doors. Sidelights and transoms can be used in nearly any combination, allowing arched openings to be filled by rectangular doors with arched transoms, and creating a world of possibilities for what was once a simple doorway.

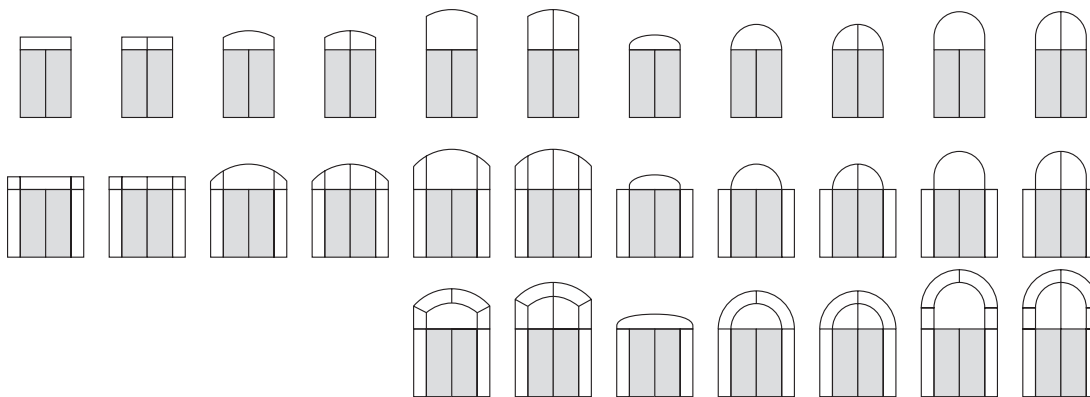
### Straightline (181)

Shown with sidelights (183), direct-glazed transom and custom grilles. Hardware purchased separately.

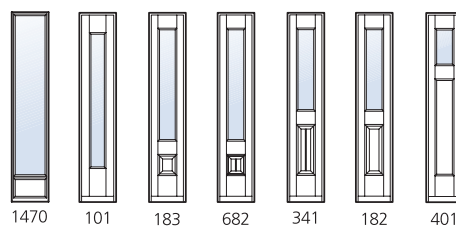

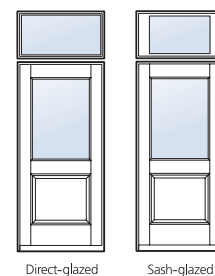

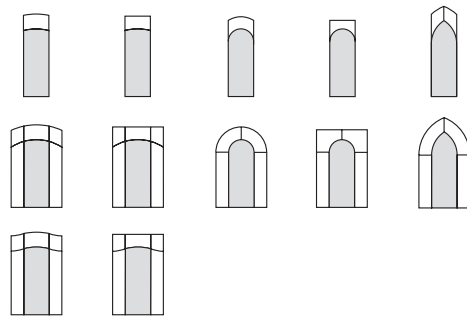

 Shown in mahogany with custom sash-glazed sidelights, transoms and custom grilles. Hardware purchased separately.

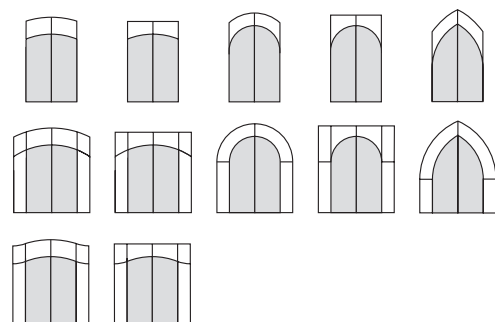
### Sidelights & Transoms

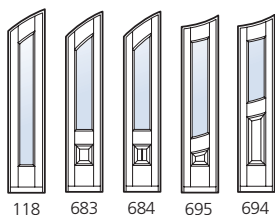
#### Single Door Configurations
