Subject: Implementation of Port Congestion Charge (PCS)

Dear HJS Valued Customer

Please be advised that HJS will charge a Port Congestion Charge to all U.S. & Mexico destined shipments received by the carrier or its agent and discharged at USWC Ports and Canadian Ports on or after Nov 17th, 2014.

It is to cover massive increase in costs arising from significant increases in port congestion and serious disruption to our normal course of operation due to labor unrest or action provided with Rule No. 23-K1 in Tariff HJSC-700.

All U.S. & Mexico destined shipments shall be subject to a Port Congestion Charge as follows:

Amount: USD 800 per 20' Container

USD 1000 per 40' Container

USD 1125 per 40' High Cube Container USD 1266 per 45' High Cube Container
