Although donation is a common and viable option for the disposal of retired IT equipment it does not address the logistics and legal liabilities associated with data destruction and the recycling of e-waste.

Furthermore, many times the charities willing to take donations of computer and IT equipment are difficult to find, and most large charities sell the assets after they receive the materials. ITAMG's main business for 11 years is buying and selling used IT Equipment of all kinds. We can raise more money for your charities through the Charity Partnership Program.

ITAMG partners with companies and their preferred charitable organizations to handle the packing and transportation of equipment, wiping of data, testing and refurbishment, EPA approved recycling of unusable materials, as well as the sale of marketable equipment.

How IT Works:

- Your organization identifies assets for disposal and ITAMG provides an upfront quote or pricing model.
- ITAMG picks up equipment, wipes data, refurbishes, and resells marketable equipment.
- All unusable or otherwise obsolete equipment is recycled appropriately with certifications.
- ITAMG issues check to your organization or sends check directly to a charity of your choosing.

Other Options:

- We handle logistics and wiping of data prior to donation of physical equipment.
- We help host consignment sales of equipment or an internal company auction of your assets.
