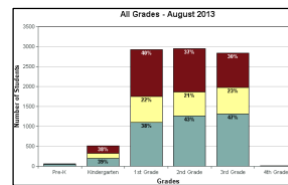
Welcome to Month 1 with Istation. This is a great time to give your students their first assessment in ISIP™. Every month a new assessment will automatically present when your students log in. For this reason you should assess your students during the first or second week of the month. You can use the Istation reports to determine students' tier levels and tailor your instruction to meet their needs. We compiled a short list of tips to assist you through this phase.

Helpful Reports:

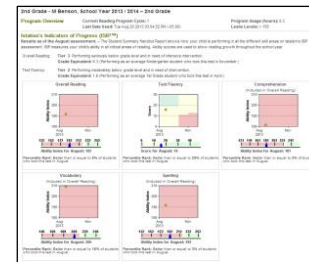
Summary Report: The ISIP Summary Report shows the number and percentage of students at each instructional tier for the current month.

Student Summary Handouts: The Student Summary Handouts Report provides student performance data from the most recently completed ISIP Assessment.

Priority Report: The Priority Report alerts teachers about students needing additional support and provides lessons focused on demonstrated weaknesses.

You can access teacher station through the Istation icon on your computer desktop. Click on the icon and log in with your user name and password. From there you can experience the tests from a student's perspective and explore teacher station, which provides virtual, interactive lessons to keep your students engaged.



Things to be aware of:

- The Early Reading ISIP Assessment will show a green **ISIP Assessment in Progress** bar during the test. When this bar goes away, the student is done testing and in the curriculum.
- The Advanced Reading ISIP Assessment will display a **PROGRESS METER** to show how far along the student is in the assessment.
- ISIP Español will show an **EVALUACIÓN EN PROGRESO** bar during the test. This bar goes away when the student finishes the assessment.
- Tier 1 students should spend 30 minutes per week in the program, Tier 2 students should spend 60 minutes per week in the program, and Tier 3 students should spend 90 minutes per week in the program to get the best results.
