All Other Construction: The later date of: (1) 2 years after last day claimant may file a lien; or (2) 1 year after date of completion, termination abandonment of work under lien. TPC §53.158.

Written notice to owner or reputed owner, with copy to the original contractor, not later than the fifteenth day of the third month following each month in which all or part of labor was performed or material delivered. (TPC §53.056 b.)

OTHER NOTICES

Residential – send notice by 15th day of the second month.

LIEN

Record lien not later than fifteenth day of the fourth month (third month, if residential) after debt accrues. TPC §53.052. (debt accrues on the last day of the last month in which labor performed or material furnished). {TPC §53.053 c.}. Must serve owner or reputed owner and original contractor a copy of the affidavit within 5 days of filing. TPC §53.055.

SUIT

Residential Construction: The later date of (1) 1 year after the last day claimant may file a lien; or (2) 1 year after date of completion, termination or abandonment or work under lien. TPC §53.158.

All Other Construction: The later date of: (1) 2 years after last day claimant may file a lien; or (2) 1 year after date of completion, termination abandonment of work under lien. TPC §53.158.

1) Written notice of debt to original contractor not later than the fifteenth day of the second month following each month in which all or part of claimant's labor was performed or delivered.

2) Written notice to owner or reputed owner and original contractor not later than the fifteenth day of the third month following each month in which all or part of labor was performed or material delivered. (TPC §53.056 b.)

<u>LIEN</u>

Lien Affidavit: Record not later than fifteenth day of the fourth month (third month, if residential) after the day on which the day on which the debt accrues (debt accrues on last day of last month in which materials were furnished). {TPC Section 53.053 c.}. Must serve owner or reputed owner and original contractor a copy of the affidavit within 5 days of filing. TPC §53.055.

<u>SUIT</u>

Residential

Construction: The later date of: (1) 1 year after the last day claimant may file a lien; or (2) 1 year after date of completion, termination or abandonment or work under lien. TPC Section 53.158.

All Other Construction:

The later date of: (1) 2 years after last day claimant may file a lien; or (2) 1 year after date of completion, termination abandonment of work under lien. TPC §53.158.

Notice to Owner: To Owner or reputed owner & contractor not later than fifteenth day of the second month following month in which the order was received and accepted by claimant. {TPC Section 53.058 b.}.

OTHER NOTICES

Notice of Unpaid Balance:

- if delivery has been made or if the normal time for delivery is passed: To original contractor not later than fifteenth day of the second month following each month in which there was performance and in addition, written notice of unpaid balance to owner or reputed owner & original contractor not later than fifteenth day of the third month following each month in which there was performance. {TPC 53.056}.

LIEN

Record lien not later than fifteenth day of fourth month (third month, if residential) after debt accrues. Debt accrues on last day materials were furnished, delivered or would normally have been required at the job site; or of month in which contract was breached or terminated by Owner or Contractor. {TPC Section 53.053 d}. Must serve owner or reputed owner and original contractor a copy of the affidavit within 5 days of filing. TPC §53.055.

SUIT

Residential

Construction: The later date of: (1) 1 year after the last day claimant may file a lien; or (2) 1 year after date of completion, termination or abandonment or work under lien. TPC Section 53.158.

All Other Construction:

The later date of: (1) 2 years after last day claimant may file a lien; or (2) 1 year after date of completion, termination abandonment of work under lien. TPC §53.158.

File suit not more than 1 year after claim perfected, if bond recorded at time lien affidavit filed, otherwise within 2 years after claim perfected. {TPC 53.208}.

If the applicable date falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, the last preceding business day should be considered as the deadline.

Notes:

1. It is important to ask the client if the contract permits its customer to withhold retainage. If it does, then a notice of non-payment MUST be sent each month, even if the balance actually due is paid.
