

Tile vs. Solid Surface

The REAL Cost of Ownership

TILE

Old structures must be removed before installation.

Grouting must be redone and maintained to avoid water being absorbed.

Old tiles need to be removed, in order to be replaced.

Scratches and abrasions lead to the need to replace tile.

Expensive.
Lengthy installation.
Expensive to repair/replace.
High life time expense.

SOLID SURFACE

Can be installed over many existing structures. Limits the need to completely remodel

No grout.
No worries of bacteria and mold growth.

Damaged pieces can sometimes be repaired instead of replaced.

Homogenous Materials
Scratches & Abrasions are easily repaired.

Easy to install.
Simple repairs.
Low cost maintenance.
Lower life time expense.
