# **CARE AND CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS**

## Meridian Quartz<sup>™</sup> Surfacing

Your Tower Industries Meridian Quartz<sup>™</sup> Surfacing has been fabricated by skilled craftsman using premium quality tools and materials. You can protect the beauty of your Meridian Quartz<sup>™</sup> and ensure a long life of trouble-free service by observing the following guidelines.

### GENERAL CARE AND CLEANING

Meridian Quartz<sup>™</sup> surfaces are easy to clean using warm water and any pH neutral, non-abrasive cleaner such as Formula 409<sup>®</sup> or Simple Green<sup>®</sup>, with a clear water rinse.

The following chemicals may be used with caution to remove difficult spots or spills from your Meridian Quartz<sup>™</sup> product: Ammonia Lysol<sup>®</sup> Cleaners Rubbing Alcohol

Ammonia<br/>Glass Cleaners containing AmmoniaLysol® CleanersRubbing AlcoholCaution should be exercised in the use, handling, or storage of any of the above chemicals or products.<br/>You should always test these chemicals in an inconspicuous area first.Rubbing Alcohol

Certain chemical substances can seriously mar your product's finish, even during brief periods of contact. Protect your Meridian Quartz<sup>™</sup> Surfacing from these harmful compounds:

Clorox<sup>®</sup> and other Hydrochlorite Bleaches Comet<sup>®</sup> (or any other abrasive cleaners) S.O.S. <sup>®</sup> Pads and all similar abrasive products Soft Scrub<sup>®</sup> (or any other product containing pumice)

DO NOT apply any sealers, waxes, penetrants, or other topical treatments to your Meridian Quartz<sup>™</sup> Surfacing under any circumstances.

### **GENERAL CAUTIONS**

- 1. Meridian Quartz<sup>™</sup> surfacing is structurally more resistant to surface damage than natural stone. However, all stone and quartz surfaces can be damaged by excessive force or pressure.
- 2. Meridian Quartz<sup>™</sup> surfaces can be damaged by sudden and rapid temperature changes, especially near the edges, as well as direct or sustained heating of the product. Your Meridian Quartz<sup>™</sup> surface may not withstand the direct transfer of heat from hot pots and pans, electric frying pans and griddles, some crock pots, some toasters and toaster ovens, and heat lamps. Therefore, the use of a hot pad or trivet is ALWAYS recommended.
- 3. Continuous, long-term exposure to direct sunlight (UV Rays) will result in discoloration of your Meridian Quartz<sup>™</sup> surfacing. This will not apply for most indoor applications.
