### How much do subscriptions cost?

### How do I use Looking at CLASSrooms?

Participants spend approximately 15 hours interacting with Looking at CLASSrooms during their 6-month subscription.

- 1. Visit the Teachstone store (store.teachstone.com) to purchase Looking at CLASSrooms subscriptions.
- 2. Focus on one CLASS dimension at a time using the corresponding **Looking at CLASSrooms unit**.
- Watch additional videos illustrating the same CLASS dimension in the Video Library. As you watch, take careful observational notes and read the accompanying focus text to help you see what's working well.
- 4. Begin observing the interactions in **your classroom**, focusing on the same CLASS dimension. Use your CLASS Dimensions Guide as a resource as you become more intentional in your interactions.
- 5. Revisit the Video Library often to deepen your understanding and guide your classroom interactions within that CLASS dimension.
- 6. Once you've completed all units, take the end of program survey and receive your certificate of completion.
