## **SEMA Approved Rack Inspections**



# Rack inspection ensures safe working environment and limits liability

#### **ISSUE**

Around 10,000 work-related injuries were recorded in the warehousing, storage and road haulage sectors in 2005-06, according to figures from the Health and Safety Executive (HSE). Failure to comply with Health and Safety guidelines and legislation can lead to potential jail sentences and unlimited fines.

The Provision and Use of Work Equipment regulations require employers to inspect equipment such as warehouse racking at "suitable intervals." SEMA (Storage Equipment Manufacturers Association) Codes of Practice also state that, for example, damaged uprights – with as little as 3mm deflection on a 1m section – should be replaced immediately.

#### **SOLUTION**

#### **INSPECTION DETAILS**

- The inspection takes place from ground level, and rear beams and splices will only be inspected where visible.
- If evidence suggests a problem with concealed parts, access will be requested.
- Where fire cladding or false ceilings prevent inspection of fixings, they will be assumed to be complete unless evidence suggests otherwise. The report will then give detailed recommendations.
- Damaged components should never be repaired but always replaced like-for-like, unless a non-conforming repair is approved.
