Important!**Passport Requirements Starting January 8, 2007**

Effective January 8, 2007, all nationals, including U.S. citizens, will be required to hold a valid passport to enter the United States by air and by sea. This also applies when coming from Canada, Mexico, Central and South America, the Caribbean and Bermuda.

The new passport requirement means that all travelers, including U.S. citizens, who are departing the U.S. and intend to re-enter the United States are required to hold a valid passport upon departure from the U.S.

Updating CheckMate 10

When you receive an update for CheckMate 10.0.0018, this update will overwrite your existing Dimensional Planner and CheckMate menu. This is necessary in order for the CheckMate user to take advantage of all the new enhancements added to the menus. It is recommended you create all your customization into one menu and import that after each new update. Instruction on importing an existing menu into CheckMate 10 is in Origin's knowledgebase "CheckMate 10 - Importing CheckMate custom menu into CheckMate 10". Be sure to read the complete document so you understand on how to backup your existing menu.

CheckMate 10.0.0026 Update Shipping

Origin customers with a current annual support plan will be receiving a CheckMate 10.0.0026 update instead of the previously announced 10.0.022. Origin felt it was important to include some last minute enhancements request from customers in this release.

- Added switch for out of tolerance flag in the cmlabdef screen.
- Enhancement to project point or line measurement normal to surface by selecting point or line then surface.
- CMTRANS enhancements - Option to load fit from Die to Body. Hold down Shift key and select Load from Fit to load Body to Die.
- Added Surface Relative Probe move – pick a point on the CAD geometry, we extract the xyzijk and the prompt for a distance in a popup appears allowing you to enter probe move there.
- Rootcause browser productivity enhancement.
- Recordings included in installation under Help >What's New in CheckMate 10.0.0022, demonstration some of the new functions.

- Added Create Excel Checklist of All Tolerances - Creates an excel checklist of all the Tolerances in the output segments. Added to both Dimensional Planner and CheckMate.
