

70% of the total funds from unclaimed gift cards are lost. They are either surrendered to the state as unclaimed property or locked in perpetual liability limbo, never allowed to expire.

- Nineteen states, including New York and Texas, collect 100% of expired or abandoned gift cards as unclaimed property.
- Seven states, including California and Florida, do not allow gift cards to expire, ever. They exist in perpetuity.
- Ten states, like North Carolina and New Jersey, collect 60% of the value from expired or abandoned gift cards as unclaimed property.
