SUSTAINABLE FACTS:

1. The eight large columns are old growth heartwood pine harvested over 100 years ago, which sank in the Suwanne River during transport. They were recently reclaimed from the riverbed and installed to support the "Bridge of Hope".
2. Over 90 TONS (76.6%) of construction waste was diverted from the landfill during construction.
3. This project is designed to save the owner 26% on it's energy costs or over \$9,150.00 annually.
