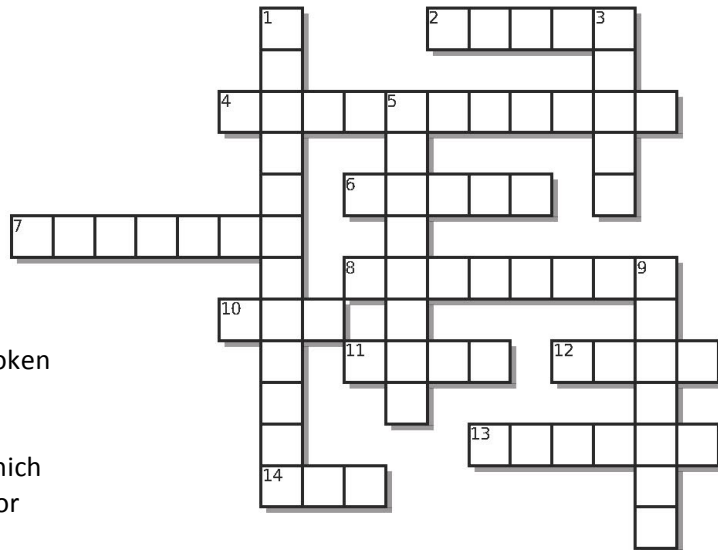




Test Your Knowledge Of Garage Door Terminology

ACROSS

- 2 Type of door comprised of sections unbroken by visible rails and stiles
- 4 Zinc coating to protect against corrosion
- 6 The vertical member of a door section which provides structural rigidity and location for hinge attachment
- 7 Thermal transmission coefficient, a measure of BTU's transmitted through one square foot of material in one hour
- 8 Horizontal distance measured into a building from the door mounting surface to the first obstruction within the zone required to install or operate the door
- 10 Acronym for Double Strength Grade B Glass
- 11 The upright framing on each side of the door opening
- 12 Acronym for inside looking out
- 13 A bar member separating panes of glass with a sash or door
- 14 A type of garage door composed of sheet metal door sections



DOWN

- 1 Material used at the perimeter of a garage door or between joints to improve performance against air infiltration
- 3 Hardware item that joins door sections together, and allows sections to pivot independent of each other
- 5 A compressible or deformable seal provided on the bottom edge of a door
- 9 A window framing member that forms a divide between units of a window
