

Reptiles Are Cool

Take an eye-opening look at the world of reptiles through this informative program that features snakes, lizards, turtles, tortoises, and alligators. Students will learn fascinating facts as they get a close-up look at reptiles creeping, leaping, crawling and climbing.

Students can even touch some reptiles, such as the Burmese python, boa constrictor, turtles and tortoises. But the Solomon Island Skink and other sharp-toothed reptiles are better left untouched. We supervise all hands-on activities to ensure the safety of students at all times. Here are some of the details that students will learn about:

Lizards, with their sleek bodies and long tails, vary in size from the 3-inch worm lizard to the 12-foot Komodo Monitor Lizard. A lizard's tongue not only helps catch prey, but sometimes serves as a nose to smell.

Turtles and tortoises have shells that can cover their entire body. This protects them from stronger, faster animals. Turtles range in size from a few inches to as tall as a full-grown man. Some weigh over 1,000 pounds. Instead of teeth, these

reptiles have jaws with razor-sharp edges.

Fresh water turtles, with their webbed feet, spend most of their lives in water. Sea turtles have broad flippers to help them navigate the sea. Tortoises, which have toes, live mostly on land.

Snakes are known to slither, crawl, swim or climb. Snakes can be as small as a 10-inch vine snake or as long as a 30-foot Anaconda snake.

The program is structured and conducted with two objectives in mind. First to entertain and hold the interests of students. Second to provide the students with a basic informational introduction to reptiles.

Students are encouraged to ask questions during the program and also, but not required, to touch the live animals and to discover for themselves why, *Reptiles are Cool.*

Assembly Information

Age Group: Kindergarten through 8th Grade

Length: Maximum of four 45-minute programs per day for one school. One or two AM or PM programs per school in a half day setting. Additional programs can be arranged at an additional fee through your program consultant.

Size: The area needed is limited only by the size of the facility.

Presentation Area: Students seated so the performer can move freely among the audience. A center aisle through the audience will allow the performer the option of moving closer to the audience during the program.

Assistance: Two 6'-8' banquet style tables. Custodial or adult assistance for unloading, set-up, tear-down and loading.

Set-up/Take-down Time: Set-up: 45 minutes. Take-down: 30 minutes. 15 minutes required between performances.
