This is an addendum to that certain contract briefly described above between XYZ Contractors, hereinafter referred to as "Contractor", and the project owner named above which is dated 8-10-00.

THE "COST OF THE WORK" INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING:

1. LABOR COSTS: All wages of construction workers directly employed by Contractor to perform the work described in the contract will be paid by the Rate Schedule below. This rate schedule is the actual amount of contractor's expense for each employee after factoring in wages, state, local, and federal taxes, medical, dental and retirement benefits, bonuses, disability and workers compensation insurance, wage based liability insurance, etc.

- 2. SUPERVISORY AND OTHER LABOR COSTS: Supervisory labor costs incurred by Contractor for any off-site labor involved in the coordination of the work or for any off-site job related meetings directly relating to the performance of the work is a part of the Cost of The Work. This off-site time will be billed to Owner and shall not exceed 12 hours per week at the rate of \$77.50 per hour unless the off-site meeting or coordination is requested by Owner or is otherwise agreed to in writing. All bookkeeping work involved in the calculation and per aration of 3 currents and invoices for payment from Owner is a part of the Cost of The Job which will be billed to Owner at the at left \$47.50 per hour and shall not exceed 4 hours per payment period.
- 3. LABOR COSTS FOR THE TIME SPENT PICKING UP MATERIALS AND PEPPARING FOR WORK: All time spent by Contractor and his employees at building material stores and tumber yards including dayed time in but directions, to pick up materials is a part of the Cost of The Work. All time spent by Contractor and his employees in preparing for work by moving tools and equipment onto the job site and away from the job site is a part of the Cost of The Work.
- 4. COST OF MATERIALS USED IN THE PERFORMANCE OF 18 WORKs Are materials purchased of contractor for the project is a part of the Cost of The Work and materials purchased utiling a payment region will be included in the amount of the invoice given to Owner by Contractor for that progress payment. The another the invoice given to Owner by Contractor for materials purchased shall be calculated by adding the actual cost of the materials at shown of the materials supplier bill plus profit and overhead on these materials at the rate of 27.4 %.
