Our team works closely with your primary physician and our **Medical Director** is available to visit you in your home.

Nurses are specially trained in pain management and symptom control. They work with patients and families to identify needs, arrange for services, supplies and medications, and coordinate care with the primary physician. They are available 24 hours a day.

Social Workers help patients and their loved ones with identifying community resources, future plans and resolution of daily problems and issues.

Hospice Aides help the patient with personal care activities, as well as light housework and meal preparation. All aides are Certified Home Health Aides, many with additional hospice certification.

Spiritual Counselors provide support in a manner which respects and honors your wishes and religious/spiritual traditions.

Bereavement Counselors offer support to grieving families and friends through one-on-one counseling, group meetings and seasonal workshops. **Trained Volunteers** make friendly visits, help with shopping and errands, and

provide respite periods for the caregiver. Some of our volunteers offer unique services including *Complementary Therapies* like Reiki, massage, and pet therapy. We are proud
