


The Catechism of the Catholic Church has four main sections, which are referred to as the four pillars. They are:

Creed

- Liturgy and Sacraments
- Morality
- Prayer

The core of *We Believe Catholic Identity Edition* is an integrated approach to faith formation, incorporating the four pillars and presenting our faith with simple, easy-to-understand language.

We Believe Catholic Identity Edition features clear and concise ways to catechize that are pedagogically sound.



In the **Student Edition**, every chapter of each grade level incorporates the four pillars through:

- The Catechetical process
 - We Gather—ritual prayer, Scripture, liturgical music (prayer, liturgy)
 - We Believe—faith statements, presentation, "As Catholics" (creed)
 - We Respond—praying and living faith (prayer, morality)
- Chapter Reviews that re-emphasize chapter content
- Reflect and Pray that engages in prayer
- Our Catholic Life that presents witnesses who live the Catholic faith
- Liturgical Chapters specifically addressing the liturgical year, the seasons, and truths of faith, which we celebrate
- WeBelieveWeb.com website that offers additional information, activities, and prayer to further stimulate students' faith
- Four Retreats per grade, each based on one of the four pillars of the Catechism of the Catholic Church


