ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR SUMMER SESSION FINANCIAL AID

- Have a 2014-2015 FAFSA on-file with UNCG at the time of applying for summer financial aid.



- Be fully admitted to or currently enrolled in an eligible degree-seeking or certificate program at UNCG.

☒ Visiting, Visions and Express students are NOT eligible to receive aid.

APPLY FOR SUMMER FINANCIAL AID:

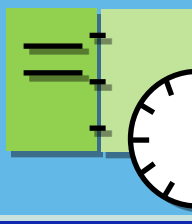
- Go to **UNCGenie** at <https://banweb.uncg.edu>
- Select **Enter Secure Area**
- Enter your log-in information
- Select **Financial Aid**
- Select **Summer Award Estimator & Application**



- Be in compliance of the Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) policy (<http://fia.uncg.edu/sap>).

Earn **67%** of Locked hours

- Be enrolled at least half-time during the summer semester.



Graduate students = 3 credit hours at the 500-level or higher
Undergraduate and graduate licensure-only students = 6 credit hours
Undergraduate students are limited to no more than 7 hours in a SINGLE session (or 14 hours for the full summer semester) unless it has been approved by the Students First Office for an overload.

TYPES OF AVAILABLE AID FOR SUMMER



Financial aid for summer generally consist of **Federal Student Aid Loan Program Funds.**



Direct Subsidized Loan:

- For undergraduates
- Interest is paid by the U.S. Department of Education while the student is in school and during periods of deferment

Direct Unsubsidized Loan:

- For undergraduates and graduate students
- Borrower is responsible for all interest

Direct PLUS Loan:

- For graduates/professional students and for parents of dependent students
- Credit-based loan
- Borrower is responsible for all interest



Grants and Scholarships are NOT typically available for Summer Session.

Some Pell Grant Recipients *may* be eligible for Pell Grant funds during the summer, if you attended less than full-time during the course of the current academic year and have remaining eligibility for funding. Additionally, some Pell Grant recipients may be eligible for Pell Grant funds during the summer even if enrolled less than half-time.

The UNCG Financial Aid Office will process your Summer Financial Aid Application to determine your eligibility for summer aid.

DETERMINING YOUR SUMMER ELIGIBILITY

Your eligibility for federal student loans during the summer is based on a number of factors, including:

- Your grade level
- Number of credit hours you will be taking
- How much you've already borrowed during the current academic year (here at UNCG and/or elsewhere)
- How much you've borrowed cumulatively from the Federal Student Aid Loan Program throughout your college career



Not all students will be eligible for financial aid for Summer Session.

You will not be eligible for any Summer Session financial aid if you have:

- Borrowed your yearly limit or your overall aggregate (total) limit on federal student loans
- Have received your full yearly allotment of Pell Grants funds

Your summer award will reflect your full eligibility for all types of available aid. UNCG cannot guarantee that your awarded financial aid will cover all of your summer expenses

DISBURSEMENT OF FINANCIAL AID FUNDS

Disbursement of funds will depend on:

Number of **sessions** in which you are enrolled.

Number of **credit hours** for which you are enrolled.

Types of financial aid you are awarded.



Summer financial aid will begin disbursing at the start of **YOUR FIRST** summer session of enrollment.

If enrolled only in Session II, funds will not disburse until the start of that session.

No financial aid will be disbursed until summer session classes begin and you are fully enrolled in ALL of the hours noted on your summer session application

PROCEED WITH CAUTION



UNDERGRADUATES: Summer enrollment is limited to no more than 7 hours in a single session (or 14 hours total for the full summer semester) unless the courses have been approved by the **STUDENTS FIRST OFFICE** for an overload.

Your summer financial aid will be canceled if you fail to enroll for the number of hours your reported on your summer application.

Add/Drop Summer Classes

Once financial aid has been disbursed for Summer Session, there can be **no adjustments** to your original award if you add a class.

However, if you drop a class after your funds have disbursed, an adjustment to your aid may be required and may result in you **owing** a repayment of funds.
