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As the student enrollment increased in Health Technologies at Assabet Valley Regional Technical High School, instructors like Kathy Regan faced some new challenges. They now needed to provide nearly three times as many sets of textbooks. And, they now had a much more diverse student body. Looking for an economical and effective solution, Regan found HealthCenter21 online. ## <u>Situation</u>

The Health Technologies program at Assabet Valley Regional Technical High School nearly tripled in enrollment two years ago.
