Latest EHS Regulations Updates Assist Companies to Achieve EHS Compliance

Highlights of selected legislation covered in the newly updated protocol include:

- Argentina has adopted the 5th edition of the United Nation's Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labelling of Chemicals (GHS) in "Resolution No. 801 of April 10, 2015." There are no additional detailed requirements in the Resolution to supplement the United Nations document.
- "Resolution No. 3068 of November 17, 2014" now includes the Argentine Electrotechnical Association (AEA)"Regulations for the Performance of Works with Voltage in Electric Installations of Less Than or Equal to One Kilovolt (1 kV)" for work with low voltage.
- In construction, "Resolution No. 503 of March 12, 2014" has been issued with safety requirements for manual and mechanical excavations of open trenches and pits greater than 1.20 meters deep.
- "Resolution No 886 of April 22, 2015" approves the "Ergonomic Protocol" as a tool to prevent musculoskeletal disorders and hernias. The protocol includes 4 forms which must be used for ergonomic risk assessment and implementation of corrective actions, along with detailed instructions of how to use the forms.
- New national regulations for safe operation of forklifts have been issued in "Resolution No 960 of May 4, 2015"
- "Resolution No. 525 of February 24, 2015" consolidates previous reporting requirements into a single "Administrative Procedure for Reporting Accidents and Occupational Diseases." In addition, several new regulations have been issued with updated instructions for how to file reports online at the SRTs portal.
