Questions and Answers:

Q: How can I activate the full MimioStudio™ license after the 30 day free trial?

A: Activating your MimioStudio license couldn't be simpler! You can activate the license by connecting any MimioClassroom product to your computer.

Q: Does the software and files work for countries outside the United States?

A: As long as you have the MimioStudio software downloaded and installed on your computer, you will be able to use the software and open any Mimio created file. You can download the MimioStudio software at http://mimio.com/support/downloads. The software is available for Windows, Mac, and Linux operating systems. You will be able to choose from an English version or Multi-language version. Languages currently supported can be found on the software download page.

Q: Where can I find my MimioConnect® password if I forgot it?

A: Just visit MimioConnect and on the top-right of the page where you login, you will see "Forgot Your Password?" Click the link and you'll be prompted to type in either your username or email address that your account is registered under. It is suggested to type in your email address in case you aren't sure of your Username. An email will be sent with further information to reset your password. If you have any other issues, contact us at training@mimio.com and we'll be glad to assist.

Q: Can you edit lessons found on MimioConnect?

A: Yes! This is the power of using teacher created lessons you find on the MimioConnect® online community without reinventing the wheel. Using a series of tools in the MimioStudio software, you can manipulate and modify anything in any lesson. Learn how to maximize the use of MimioStudio software in our MimioTraining™ Quick Learn sessions. Great sessions to learn how to edit include MimioStudio: Putting Instructional Design to Work, A Tour of MimioStudio, and MimioStudio: Formatting I.

Q: Can I view lessons with an earlier version of the MimioStudio software?

A: If you have an older version of the MimioStudio software, it will not open any file created with a newer version of the software. You will get a prompt indicating that the file was created in a newer version of the software. You will need to update your software to the latest version by visiting our Software Download page.

Q: How do I become a member of MimioConnect?

A: It's easy! Visit the <u>MimioConnect</u> educator community and click on "<u>Click Here to Register</u>" under the *Why Become a Member* section on the right. Enter some brief information about yourself; select a username and password, and you are set to explore all the wonders of the MimioConnect site. Q: If I want to improve a lesson what would you suggest?

A: We have a number of resources available to support you along the way. Our <u>Quick Learn</u> training program offers a number of free training sessions, including "MimioStudio: Putting Instructional Design to Work". Q: Can I import files I already have into the MimioStudio software, such as PowerPoint files?

A: You can insert a number of resources into the MimioStudio software, including other interactive whiteboard files. You don't have to start from scratch. Use the "insert file" ability of MimioStudio software to insert your existing Word, PDF, and PowerPoint files right into the software, and then add a few elements to make them interactive.
