

PHC Alumni Association Tuition Scholarship 2013 Essay Prompt

Scholarship Amount: \$2,000

Eligibility: Any full-time student of Patrick Henry College as of the Spring 2013 semester with applicable tuition expenses who will return to PHC for Fall 2013. Students with a full tuition waiver are not eligible.

Length: 1,000 words maximum.

Please write your essay using one of the prompts below, on the theme of personal and academic development. Only one essay may be submitted per student, and one overall winner will be selected (not one for each topic).

Prompt 1: What idea or ideas have resonated with you during your time at Patrick Henry College (either inside or outside of the classroom) that you believe will impact you most significantly for the rest of your life? Why?

Prompt 2: What experiences have most challenged or shaped you while at Patrick Henry College? Examples might include exhilarating or difficult incidents with classes, professors, friends, family, or internships.

Essays are graded on their mechanics, logic, rhetorical effect, and development of topic. The recipient of the award will be notified prior to the Fall 2013 semester tuition due date.
