Frequently Asked Questions

Q. How long does it take to earn a Private Pilot Certificate?

A. On average, a Private Pilot Certificate can be obtained in a period of 3 months to one year and usually approximately 75 hours. The FAA requires a minimum 40 hours of flight time. Of the 40 hours, 20 must be with an instructor and at least 10 must be solo.

Q. At what age can I earn a Pilot Certificate?

A. The FAA requires a minimum age of 16 for solo flight and 17 for a certificate, however you may begin flight instruction at any age. Shoreline Aviation has had students ranging in age from 10-85.

Q. How often can I schedule an appointment to fly?

A. You may schedule flights as often as you like. We recommend trying to fly at least once a week to help you retain information and lower the overall training costs. Our instructors give lessons seven days a week, from 8 am to sunset.

Q. Does Shoreline have specific days for introductory flights?

A. Introductory flights are generally scheduled Thursdays through Sundays.9 AM until 3 PM.

Q. How do I start my flight lessons?

A. Our customer service personnel will be happy to schedule an appointment, either in person or over the phone.

Q. Do I need a medical exam to begin taking lessons?

A. No, you do not need an FAA medical exam until you are ready for your first solo flight, but we do advise students to get a medial early in their training in case there are any unknown, underlying issues which will exempt the student from flying privileges.

Q. What security documents do I need to begin my training?

A. At the second lesson, the Transportation Security Agency (TSA) requires us to document proof that our student is a U.S. Citizen. An unexpired U.S. passport, or a driver's license **and** an original birth certificate are required. We need to keep a record on file here at the airport.
