- Specialized care for Alzheimer's/dementia and mobility disorders

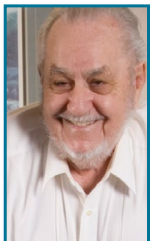
Home Assist™ private-pay services are a cost-effective alternative to traditional assisted living facilities.
