MAY 24 — 27, 2016

The Executive Leadership program is designated for senior bank officers who wish to hone their skills in leading their bank to higher levels of performance. The program provides attendees the opportunity to attend lectures at the school and participate in classes addressing the topic of leadership taught by experts in the field.

This 2 1/2 day program is designed to accommodate the desire of the school's graduates to return to campus to expand and update their knowledge of industry developments and to enhance their leadership skills.

The program features nine hours of lecture on the topic of leadership taught by the Dr. Richard White, Dean of the College of Business at LSU who in addition to his academic qualifications is a retired officer and ship commander in the U. S. Coast Guard. The topic is also addressed by long-time faculty member Dr. Bruce Bickel.

The economic outlook will be addressed at dinner on Wednesday, May 25 by Dr. Loren Scott. Coach Skip Bertman will talk to the group at dinner on Thursday evening.

The Executive Leadership group will stay in the Lod Cook Hotel on campus and will attend classes on campus and in the Lod Cook Alumni Center adjacent to the hotel.

Because of limited hotel accommodations, enrollment in the program is limited to 25 and applications will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. The cost of the program is \$2,450 which includes hotel, meals and instruction.

Graduates of the program will receive a diploma of completion from the Graduate School of Banking Leadership Program.
