Lodging

Room assignments are made prior to registration. You will receive a memo indicating your housing and elective assignments prior to your arrival on campus. Apartments will be available for occupancy beginning at 9:00am Sunday, May 22, through 1:30pm Friday, June 3.

The School furnishes a pillow, pillowcase, set of sheets, and a lightweight blanket. A supply of 5 towels and 10 washcloths is provided along with detergent to launder these as needed. LSU housekeeping staff will enter the apartments daily to clean the bathrooms and make beds; bed linens will be changed on Friday only.

Each bedroom maintains its own locking system. GSB is not responsible for any lost items, computers, etc. left in your apartment.

Each apartment has a kitchen with a refrigerator, stove, microwave, dishwasher, and garbage disposal. No detergent, kitchenware or utensils are provided. The School does **NOT** furnish an alarm clock, telephone, television, iron, or hair dryer. Each apartment has a clothes washer and dryer; detergent is provided to launder towels. Each bedroom has a basic cable TV jack and Ethernet data connection. If you bring a TV, you must also bring the cable for connection. You should bring your cell phone and charger.

Clothing

Casual dress (jeans, slacks, t-shirts, walking shorts, tennis shoes, sandals) is suitable attire for all class lectures and official assemblies, **except for graduation**. The median temperature in Baton Rouge in May is 80 degrees, and the average rainfall is about 4 inches. It is advisable to bring lightweight clothing and a raincoat or umbrella.

RICOH Mail & Copy Services is located on the first floor of the LSU Union in Rooms 101 and 103 and is available Monday-Friday from 7:30 am-5:00 pm. Services include black and white copies, color copies, binding, faxing and scanning. Their telephone number is 225-578-6756.

Back Packs

Each Freshman will receive a customized back pack along with a temporary luggage tag to be used during their three years at the school. Juniors and Seniors should bring their backpack from last year.

Airport/Bus Transportation

Bus transportation is provided from the BR airport to the LSU campus Sunday, May 22, from 9:00am to 6:00pm. Special buses chartered by GSB will leave the airport every 15-30 minutes.

Bus service will also be provided to transport students to the BR airport on Friday, June 3, after the final exam, from 10:00am until 1pm. Apartments close at 1:30pm.

Parking

Spaces are available around the apartments. Permits for parking only in apartment/dorm lots (indicated by a green "Reserved-3-Residents" sign) are available at registration, and should be placed on the rear view mirror. Read and observe the campus traffic regulations posted in ECA. Violators will be ticketed by Campus Security, and violations will normally result in a \$50 fine payable at the Office of the Bursar. Cars parked in unauthorized areas will be towed away at the owner's expense. Parking is limited on campus, and all students are advised to walk to their classes. If you have a bicycle on campus, you should bring a bicycle lock.

Registration

Registration begins at 9:00am on Sunday, May 22. Upon arrival on the LSU campus, <u>ALL students will check in at the Nora Power ACTIVITY BUILDING at East Campus Apts.</u> First, go to Room #2 (GSB desk) where you will receive a packet containing all course materials. **HANG ONTO YOUR KEYS.** The charge for replacing a lost apartment bedroom key is \$60; and for an apartment outside door key is \$65.

Email/Internet Access

To check email or access the Internet, computers are available in the ECA Activity Center.

An Internet connection is also available in your bedroom. Your computer must have an Ethernet adapter, and you need a Category 6 (CAT6) cable to connect from your computer to the outlet. Make sure your computer is set to obtain an IP address automatically. Printed instructions to connect your computer to the LSU Network for an Internet connection, including username/password, will be in your course material binder. Wireless access to the Internet can be received in your apartment living area, bedroom, and common areas.

LSU staff will answer questions on Sunday, May 22, from 1:00-4:00pm in the ECA Activity Center.

Recreational Facilities

The <u>Student Recreational Sports Complex</u> will be open on May 23—June 3. The hours are:

Monday - Thursday 5:45am—9:00pm Friday 5:45am—8:00pm Saturday—Sunday Noon-8:00pm

The fee will be \$35.00 for 1 week; \$50.00 for 2 weeks. You will need to **complete and fax** the University Recreation Form prior to the Session; **fax to the SRSC office**. Once you have arrived at LSU, you will need to go to the University Recreation Guest Services, located in the SRSC, during their <u>registration hours</u> which are listed on the University Recreation Form, to make payment and receive your validated pass.

Jogging—Jogging paths are located around the L.S.U Lakes.

Golf—The L.S.U. Golf Course and the Golf Range will be open daily. Electric carts and pull carts will be available for rental. Green fees will be charged.

Tennis—Tennis courts are normally open for free play on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Racquetball Courts—Outdoor 3-wall courts (*located near tennis courts*) are usually open for recreational play seven days per week. The Student Recreational Sports Complex will be open for recreational play.

Swimming—The Student Recreational Sports Complex will be available for swimming laps and water basketball.

Messages

During the Session, GSB personnel will be in Room 2 in the ECA Activity Center, 225-578-5019 Monday—Friday from 7:30am—9:00am, 11:00am—1:30pm, 6:00pm-8:00pm; Saturday from 7:00am—1:00pm; and Sunday from 3:00—7:00 pm. Messages will be posted on the dry eraser board in Room 2. Students cannot be called out of class for messages except in case of medical emergency.

LSU personnel will be at the Activity Center's main desk from 7:00am to midnight. After hours, the name and phone # of an "on call" LSU staff member will be posted on the door. Report apartment maintenance or any emergency problem to the LSU front desk at 225-334-4248, or after hours, call the LSU "on call" staff. The doors to the Center will be locked at midnight.
