Everything is crisp, clean-lined, and sharp. Wires are hidden, paper is at a minimum, and the workspace focus is upon the computers.

"It was important to be thoughtful about the way we're set up from a technology standpoint, especially since it's such a huge aspect of our future business," added Rob Dube. "For any customers that come in, prospects, and people that we're recruiting to work here, we want to present an environment that is progressive and that attracts the best people."

There isn't an area in the office without careful thought. Wood floors and neutral carpeting have a peaceful effect. Most of the walls are white, but a few of them display bright orange or blue-"pops" of color that represent boosts of energy. Idea paint coats certain walls, allowing team members to write directly on the surface. The previous ceilings enclosed you into an area; now, high ceilings create openness between departments and welcome natural light.

"Our goal is to take complex print environments or workflow and simplify it for our customers. We now have a feeling of simplicity engrained in our minds through the physical space," says Rob. "This represents us and what we do for our customers."
