## BEST PRACTICES FOR A LUSH LAWN

### WATER GAUGE TIPS

1. To gauge watering, place an empty can about 6 ft. away from the sprinkler.
2. When there is an inch of water in the can, it is time to move the sprinkler.
3. Check wind pattern to be sure desired area is being watered.
4. Reflected heat along buildings dries sod quickly; be sure to water these areas more often.

### TRAFFIC CAUTION

1. Good root establishment takes 2-3 weeks, so limit traffic in newly sodded areas.
2. Avoid concentrated play activities, dog traffic or similar rough usage until 4 weeks have passed.

### MOWING TIPS

1. Your new lawn generally needs mowing 14-16 days after installation.
2. The basic mowing rule is never remove more than 1/3 of the leaf blade during a single mowing.
3. Set your mower at a cutting height of approximately 3-1/2".
4. Remember: always keep your mower blades sharp to avoid damage to your new lawn.

It is the responsibility of each Homeowner to maintain the sod on their lot. These steps will assist you in developing a beautiful lawn.
